

Minutes of Meeting of Eva Town Council held August 8, 1988, 10 A.M., attended by the Mayor and Councilmen Nichols, Livingston, Hipps and Morgan.

Since this was the first meeting of the Council since the closeout of qualifying as candidates for the municipal election set for August 23, the Council passed Resolutions declaring the following as duly elected to the respective offices noted, since they were unopposed. Their term of office commences on October 3, 1988:

Roland Ryan - Mayor	(M:Livingston; S:Morgan; carried)
Charles Nichols - Council Place 1	(M:Morgan; S:Hipps; carried)
Mitchell Hipps - Council Place 4	(M:Nichols; S:Livingston; carried)
Bert L. Collins - Council Place 5.	(M:Hipps; S:Nichols; carried)

Mayor said that the basic reason for the call meeting is for the council to appoint election officials for the August 23 election, and, after Clerk reported that Mr. Perry Requemore of the Alabama League of Municipalities had said that since the Mayor was automatically elected, that his wife Frances could serve as an election officer; the Council passed a Resolution naming the following as election officers:

Desmonee Driver as Returning Officer; James Afton Fowler as Inspector;
Marigurette Livingston Alexander and Frances Norris Ryan as Clerks.

Mayor then signed the Notice to be posted naming said election officers.

Council discussed getting someone to clean out the shrubbery beds at the Center, and trimming the shrubbery. The grass and weeds will have to be pulled out by hand or sprayed with 24D. Clerk will contact some people about this.

Mayor said that Kermit Morris is supposed to give us a plan for landscaping at the Library and the Medical Center. Council then discussed some other projects that need to be done, as well as those under way which the Council voted on at last meeting.

IN OTHER ACTIONS, THE COUNCIL VOTED TO:

- 1-Get someone to paint (perhaps a cream or beige color) the outside wood at the Library, and to landscape it. (M:Nichols; S:Morgan; carried)
- 2-Get Charles Frost to proceed with bricking around the dental clinic, and to purchase some extra bricks which will be needed for the job; and to pay for the bricks at a cost of aprx \$250. (M:Morgan; S:Hipps; carried)
- 3-Pave the drive around the back of the Library while they are at it, understanding that the cost would be in excess of the bid from Shelby as presented at last Council Meeting. (M:Nichols; S:Morgan; carried)
- 4-Get someone ~~to~~ to put timbers at the base of the bank on the corner lot, and to landscape it with small shrubbery similar to what they did at the school. (M:Nichols; S:Morgan; carried)
- 5-Widen the driveway at the entrance to Rojo Manufacturing. (M:Livingston; S:Nichols; carried)
- 6-With the County's help, fix a road down the line at Mrs. Stacy's to accommodate the three houses involved, which would be about 1/4 mile. (M:Nichols; S:Hipps; carried)
- 7-Order at the request of the VFD some fire prevention rules printed on rulers, with phone number for emergencies, to be handed out to students and senior citizens during National Fire Prevention Week in October. Cost would be \$240. (M:Morgan; S:Nichols; carried)

Mr. Nichols offered the motion, seconded by Mr. Hipps to adjourn.

SUBJECT: ELECTION OFFICIALS

WHEREAS, a regular municipal election has been called to be held on the 23rd day of August, 1988, and a runoff election to be held, if necessary, on the 13th day of September, 1988, and
