SUBJECT: BID OPENING FOR SHRUBBERY BEDS MAINTENANCE
IN THE TOWN OF EVA

The Town of Eva is taking bids on a twelve month contract to beginning August 1, 1990, to do the following to the shrubbery beds located at the Eva Nutrition Site/Community Center, Eva Medical Clinic, Eva Town Hall, Downtown Parking Lot, Library, and four "Welcome to Eva" signs:

1. Trim all plants as needed (minimum of twice/year).
2. Fertilize three times during growing season with fertilizer containing minor plant elements and micro nutrients. Add lime as needed for good plant growth.
3. Carry out effective weed control program utilizing preemergence herbicide, post emergence herbicide and/or manual weeding as needed.
4. Apply additional mulch as needed.
5. Replace any dead plants.

The Town of Eva agrees to pay for additional mulch if needed.

Sealed bids will be opened at 7:30 p.m. on August 9, 1990 at the Regular Session of the Eva Town Council Meeting.

Minutes of call Meeting of Eva Town Council held August 30, 1990, at 7:00 P.M. for the purpose of hiring a clerk for Town Hall. Attending the meeting were Mayor Ryan and Councilmen Nichols, Collins, Morgan, Page, and Livingston.
