

Minutes of regular meeting of Eva Town Council held on August 13, 1992, at 7:00 p.m., with Mayor Ryan, Councilmen Livingston, Page and Collins present. Present from Eva Art Guild were Marigurette Alexander, Lucretia Ryan and Cynthia Weaver. Present from Eva Activities was Chris Ryan.

Meeting opened with prayer by Councilman Page. Motion by Mr. Livingston, second by Mr. Collins (carried) to dispense with the reading of the minutes until hearing from our visitors.

Prior to the 7:00 meeting time, the Mayor and Council met with Principal Thompson at Eva School for a tour of the facilities.

Eva Art Guild stated that they would like to find out what the Town would do to help support Frontier Days. Mayor Ryan stated the budget is \$2,500.00 and the Town will do whatever is necessary to promote Frontier Days. Clerk will arrange for Port-O-Let Services as in the past. The Art Guild also requested for the Town to join Alabama Tourism Bureau. The Bureau provides extensive advertising for members. Clerk to fill out application and pay membership dues of appx. \$150. The Art Guild has scheduled activities for each day with the parade being on Saturday, September 26. A stage is needed and the Art Guild will get an estimate on costs and advise Council so they can make a decision on this project. It was also requested that the Mayor write a letter to Principal Murphy at Brewer requesting the Band's presence at the parade. There will also be advertising expenses, prize money, sound system expense, Band expense, etc. Art Guild thanked the Council for their support and will report back at the next meeting.

Chris Ryan stated the activities will be pouring concrete and trying to put tops on the dugouts at the ballfields. They will also have appx. \$1,000 for lighting the Horseshoe Pits. Further budget discussions will be at the September Budget Work Session.

OLD BUSINESS:

1. Recreation Park:
 - a) Horseshoe Pit Cover - Clerk has received notice of Completion. Council will do final inspection and advise Clerk for payment or corrections.
 - b) Storage Area - Fence report - Clerk received estimate of \$1,130.00 to fence in storage area with an 8' and 4' gate from Jones Fence. Motion by Mr. Collins, second by Mr. Livingston (carried) to have fence work done.
2. North Ala. EMS Adv. Life Support License still in process.
3. Pending Joe Wheeler Lawsuit - Mayor has received letters from attorney handling the suit and no decision has been reached to date.
4. Deputy Contract - Contract has been signed and mailed to County Commission. Contract amount is same as last year.

5. Highway Paving Update - no new information available.
6. Industrial Park Update:
Mayor stated the sale of 4 acres has been completed at a price of \$3113.34 per acre.
7. Medical Board Appointment - paperwork not ready from attorney yet.
8. Property Purchase Update - Mayor Ryan completed the purchase today.
9. Town Hall/VFD Hall floor stripped and waxed.
10. "Welcome to Eva" sign maintenance has not been completed.
11. Stop Light/Signs update - not available due to absence of Mr. Nichols.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. School Update - Motion by Mr. Collins, second by Mr. Page (carried) to purchase new chalk boards for Eva School out of this year's budget.
2. Motion by Mr. Collins, second by Mr. Page (carried) to approve Resolution 92-8 for Officer Elected without Opposition.
3. Certificate of Election issued to Roland Ryan, Mayor.
4. Motion by Mr. Livingston, second by Mr. Page (carried) to approve Resolution 92-9 - Payment for Election Officials.
5. Election Update - called meeting to be held to canvass election results on August 25, at 8:00 p.m.
6. Motion by Mr. Collins, second by Mr. Page (carried) for Fire Chief to hire Donald Holmes to sand and repaint all fire hydrants and spray weed killer.
7. William Chaffin (Eva Tire) requested the culvert at the curve be extended for safety reasons. Motion by Mr. Livingston, second by Mr. Page (carried) to extend the culvert up to 20', if necessary.
8. Motion by Mr. Collins, second by Mr. Page (carried) to approve July 9, July 15, July 17 and August 8 minutes as written.
9. Motion by Mr. Page, second by Mr. Livingston (carried) to pay bills and transfer funds as requested.
