

Minutes of the Meeting of the Eva Town Council held in regular session on Dec. 11, 1980, attended by the Mayor, Councilmen Livingston, Morgan, Nichols and Hipps.

Minutes of the Nov. 13 meeting were read and approved. Financial report giving end-of-November balances was accepted as presented:

General Fund	\$1208.38
Gasoline Tax Fund	\$ 86.25
Revenue Sharing Fund	\$ 613.76
Volunteer Fire Dept.	\$ 742.41 (with \$25 in transitory funds)
Passbook Savings (Gen.Fd.)	\$ 32.88

The Mayor announced the receipt of a check from the Morgan County Commission in the amount of \$20,098.22 to be deposited into the General Fund from the 2% school tax. Mr. Nichols offered the motion, seconded by Mr. Hipps that we go ahead and give the \$18,600 as pledged to the school. Motion carried.

Another item of old business was the porch and cover at the Senior Citizens Center. The porch is in the process of being built.

#### New Business:

The Eva Lions Club donated to the Volunteer Fire Dept. \$376.95, which was their balance on hand, and since they do not plan to try to meet for the time being since there isn't enough interest to keep it going. The Clerk will try to arrange to get a writeup and picture in the paper showing a member of the Lions Club presenting the check to John Smith, the Fire Chief.

The possibility of paying off the fire hydrant note was discussed. Although no decision was reached, the discussion was that when the next check from the county is received that we might do this.

Bills presented for payment were: Net phone bill \$34.23; Water bill \$6.76; Clerk's salary for November \$83.94; Gas for fire trucks \$40.44; Butane Gas for Fire Dept. \$80.00. Mr. Morgan offered the motion, seconded by Mr. Nichols that said bills be paid. Motion carried.

The Mayor read the letter from Attorney General Graddick offering to give his assistance wherever needed.

Mr. Nichols offered the motion, seconded by Mr. Livingston that we prepare for and put in a 220 heater, and carpet, the Clerk's office. Motion carried.

The Clerk will send out reminders to the vendors and businesses in the Town of Eva, that privilege licenses are due and payable before January 31st.

There being no further business, Mr. Hipps offered the motion that the meeting be adjourned.
