

Minutes of Special Call Meeting held December 2, 1982, with the Mayor and all five Councilmen present.

The Mayor stated that the meeting was called to discuss the addition or expansion to the Eva Health Clinic, and read the information received from Marsha Aldridge as to the requirements, which were:

Two separate rooms would be required for the Lab and X-Ray.

X-Ray room would need lavatory for developing; would need lead-shielded walls. Southeastern Co. in Alabaster sells paneling with lead attached. Marsha said no problem for them to get the paneling for the wall between the lab and X-Ray room.

X-Ray machine and table are very heavy. The mobile unit, if this is what is decided to buy, should have the floor reinforced under the X-Ray room.

The Lab would need a counter and access to a bathroom lavatory, or a small lavatory of its own for washing up equipment, etc.

Kenneth Thomas with State Radiology told Marsha that he didn't see any problem for housing this in a mobile unit, as long as it had the extra support for the X-ray equipment.

After some discussion, it was decided we needed more specific requirements, such as how high the X-Ray ceiling would have to be; the weight of the machine, and if it is portable; weight of the table, etc.

Council would like to have one or two contractors give us bids on the building as soon as we have more specific requirements; also to have Flanagan Mobile Homes in Huntsville give a bid.

Also, have the doctors say what they would do--how they would lay out--an aprx. 30x14' building. Give this information to Marsha so that she could work this into the blueprints or drawings.
