

Minutes of Meeting of Eva Town Council held in regular session at 7 p.m., Dec. 13, 1984, attended by the Mayor and Councilmen Livingston, Morgan, Nichols and Page. Minutes of the October 16 call meeting and the November 8 regular meeting were read and approved. A financial report was presented, giving the following balances:

Business Discussed:

- 1-Need to get our map ready and in on extending our town limits. The legislature will meet for a short session before Christmas and then again after Christmas. We need to get in touch with Mr. Woodruff, the County Engineer, and get him to go with us to the Court House to designate those 40's we want to take in.
- 2-Need to send Joe Summerford for the County Commission all the money we have taken in from the RRR Gasoline Tax to help pay on the paving of roads in Eva. Mr. Nichols offered the motion seconded by Mr. Page to send that money in to Joe. Clerk will prepare a letter and check for the Mayor to sign which will be around \$2800.
- 3-Need to write to the Office of Revenue Sharing to ask for a waiver of publishing information in the newspaper on how we have spent and plan to spend Revenue Sharing Funds. Clerk will prepare the letter for the Mayor to sign.
- 4-Need to find someone who can repair the cracks in the walls in the bathroom and the East wall of the Fire Hall. Someone mentioned a Mr. Chambers or perhaps Ezra Drinkard. This needs to be done before the weather gets too bad.
- 5-The North Ala. EMS is offering grants to EMT's which would be matching money for EMT Trauma Kits, on a 50/50 basis. Eva needs 2 more kits; one for Keith Pruitt, paramedic, and one for Harold Moses who will soon have his EMT Basic license. The kits would cost Eva \$63.82 each. Mr. Livingston offered the motion, seconded by Mr. Nichols to pay for Eva share of the two kits. Motion Carried. Cost for the 2 kits to Town of Eva would be \$127.64 from VFD money.
- 6-Mayor presented information obtained on the Alabama League of Municipalities and the advantages in belonging to this organization. Dues for Town of Eva would be \$150 per year. Mr. Page offered the motion seconded by Mr. Morgan to join the League. It was stated that at the end of the year if we thought it worthwhile we could vote on whether to continue in it.
- 7-Discussed the request from the Forestry Commission and County Association of Vol. Fire Depts. about writing to our legislators asking them to approve legislation to increase the Forestry budget. It was decided not to do this at the present time.
- 8-Discussed need to get the flag pole up. The man from Joe Wheeler never came back out. Discussed possibility of getting assistance from the Volunteer Firemen in getting it put up.
- 9-Mr. Page offered the motion, seconded by Mr. Nichols to pay the bills as presented which were: From General Fund. Morgan County for Dec. on deputy salary \$833.33; interest on the \$40,000 loan Aprx. 300; 2 water bills @ \$8.06-\$16.12; Net phone bill \$87.62; Clerk's salary for November \$146.76; Agnes Weeks for 2 hours of cleaning @ \$3.65-\$7.30; Miscellaneous office supplies \$3.94; Electric Bills - Town Hall Aprx \$30; Senior Center Aprx \$55; Howard Millwood for 1 mowing \$12.50. From Volunteer Fire Dept. Blackboard; easel and sketch pads \$138.12*; Cal-Gas \$99; Joe's Texaco ^{Station} for #215 \$30; Ryan's Gulf gas \$5; North Alabama EMS matching money for 2 trauma kits @ \$63.82-\$127.64*; flowers for Joe Marsh funeral \$40; Eva Four-Way Gas for #126 \$10. From Gasoline Tax Fund. Street lights Aprx \$130.

*Money to be transferred from Revenue Sharing Funds.

There being no further business, Mr. Nichols offered the motion, seconded by Mr. Page, to adjourn.
