

Minutes of the regular meeting of the Eva Town Council held on December 10, 2013, 6:30 p.m. at the Eva Town Hall. Present: Mayor Livingston, council members Jim Henderson, Johnny Persall, Martin Nelson, Kent Chambers, Brandlee Shadded and Clerk Judy Fortenberry.

Mayor called the meeting to order; all council members present. After roll call, informed all present that we open our meetings with prayer, if anyone objected we would abstain from this practice at tonight's meeting. No one objected, Mayor asked Mr. Nelson to open with prayer.

A: FINANCE, EDUCATION & LIBRARY– MR. CHAMBERS

It should be noted that the security will be done in phases and this will be Phase I.
