Also talked about the gas tanks being removed, he has to bids one from CDG for \$5,100 and the other from Terracon out of Birmingham for \$4,240.

After discussing Mr. Chambers motion to proceed with the tank test and removal and the building. Was agreed the mayor would talk with both companies and decided on which to go with.

Mayor also reported he had talked with William Neal about the light at the storm shelter at the park, if they use the pole that is there now he can install for around \$1,800.

Mr. Henderson motion to install, Mr. Persall seconded, carried. Mayor will call Mr. Neal.

Mayor ask if anyone else had anything to bring up, The Doctor reported that the medical clinic will be closed except for 2 days a week for a few weeks, they are looking for a Medical Doctor to work here in the clinic as it is not working out here at present. Hopefully they can find a doctor that will come out here full time, in the near future, they do not want to close the clinic. Doctor left the meeting at 8:15.
