

Minutes of the regular meeting of the Eva Town Council held on April 10, 2018, 6:30 P.M. at the Eva Town Hall. Present: Mayor Gary Livingston, Council members Kent Chambers, Ripley Fowler, Johnny Persall, Edsel Childers, Martin Nelson, and Town Clerk Judy Fortenberry

Mayor called the meeting to order; all council members present. After roll call Mayor Livingston informed all present that we open our meetings with prayer, if anyone objected we would abstain from this practice at tonight's meeting. No one objected, Mayor Livingston asked Mr. Nelson to open with prayer.

Mayor thanked everyone for coming to the meeting. The Mayor informed all present that we would be swearing in Ripley Fowler to Place # 4 on the Town of Eva Council, Mr. Fowler took the Oath of Office at this time, Mayor welcome Mr. Fowler to the Council.

A: FINANCE, EDUCATION & LIBRARY– MR. CHAMBERS

Mayor presented Resolution No. 18-01 – A Resolution for funding in the amount of \$28,500.00 between the Town of Eva and the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs to be purchase materials for the storm water drainage system in front of the Eva Public Library along Hwy 55 East.

Council member Childers moved that all rules governing the council which might, unless suspended, prevent the passage and adoption of Resolution No. 18-01 at this meeting is and the same are hereby suspended for the purpose of permitting the resolution to be finally passed and adopted at this meeting.

Council member Persall seconded this motion.
