

Minutes of the regular town council meeting held on August 11, 1998, at 6:30 P.M. in the Eva Town Hall. Present: Mayor Livingston, C. C. Mosteller, James Fowler, Clarence Alexander, Bert Collins, and Larry Smith absent due to employment commitment. Guest present: Steven Henderson, resident. After roll call, Mr. Alexander opened the meeting with prayer.

After reading minutes, motion by Mr. Collins to approve minutes, second by Mr. Fowler, carried.

FINANCE & EDUCATION - MR. MOSTELLER

Mr. Mosteller advised that Friends of Library are still working on fund raiser for Library addition. He then asked if a contract is needed with Curtis Kirsch, Architect? Mayor stated he would ask Mr. Smith to contact Mr. Kirsch on a contract agreement

UTILITIES - MR. ALEXANDER

Mr. Alexander advised that a water leak in front of Gwinn Mason's house on right-of-way has been repaired. Mayor advised that the leak on Frost Road was also repaired and then added that Don Stisher, Morgan County Comm. Dist. #3 has stated that the Duck Creek water project will cause the water bills to increase.

STREETS, PARKS, & CEMETERIES - MR. FOWLER

Mr. Fowler stated that the fire department has advised him that grass under the picnic table and walking trail is too tall and could be a hazard. He will ask the Eva Art Guild to clean under the table. Mayor then stated that Tommie Moore could put out grass killer on the trail. Mr. Fowler reported that he has ordered a canopy for the tractor.

Mr. Collins advised that John Smith wants the ditch mowed in front of his business. Mayor stated that it could not be done because all residents would want the same. Mr. Collins then added that Johnny Persall, town resident, has asked to do mowing for the town when Tommie Moore retires. Mr. Persall is looking for something to keep him busy. Mayor advised that he could help now getting the town cleaned up for Frontier Days since there is so much to be done in six weeks. Mr. Collins will contact Mr. Persall.

POLICE & FIRE - No Report

RECREATION & SANITATION - MR. COLLINS

Mr. Collins stated nothing has been done about concrete wall next to parking lot then Mayor added it will be reviewed after Frontier Days. Mayor advised there needs to be lots of cleanup done in town before Frontier Days. Beginning date is Saturday, September 19.
