

Agenda - Eva Town Council Meeting December 14, 1989

Old Business:

- 1-Cable TV. Mark Perry said that work is progressing steadily; they are now "building" from Baileyton toward Eva on Hwy 55; still working toward the timetable reported in November (around end of January).
- 2-Invitations to bid were mailed and picked up by a total of 7 contractors. Bid opening is set for Mon., Dec. 18, 4:30 p.m. Two sealed bids have been received.
- 3-Still need to get industries to commit to locate in industrial park before we can begin grant application. Anything new on this?
- 4-Bob Woodruff said signs should be ready to put up any day. He will bring equipment out to put them up. Cost is \$626 and he'd like to get that authorized by Council to pay the County so they can pay their bill.
- 5-Reply from Sen. Heflin on mail routes was not encouraging.
- 6-Parking lots at Medical Clinic and Library were striped and Mr. Symonds has been paid.
- 7-Ordinance on heavy duty trucks parking in Eva is not ready. No comments were received by Clerk on materials given to councilmen.
- 8-Ordinance on selling property to Joe Hill is on the table for adoption at this meeting.
- 9-Audit not yet completed. Mr. Whisenant said it is taking longer than he expected; that Eva has a lot more property and interests and there are more businesses and more bookkeeping than he expected Eva to have. He is hoping to be through in a day or two. He rescinds his suggestion to a 2-year audit; said that with everything Eva is doing now, they should have an annual audit.
- 10-Mayor has completed interviews; has resumes and notes on the table.
- 11-Mayor has information on costs of hydrants for Vann Moses road.
- 12-Has Mayor met yet with Principal of Brewer?
- 13-Census was completed today. Report is that there are 168 residences in Eva with a total of 432 people (but one residence was unoccupied and they couldn't get information on its inhabitants).

New Business:

- 1-Dr. Kuruvilla wants Mayor and Council to help spread the word and encourage people to use Eva Clinic. He said that he is there 6 days a week (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday from 9 to 4; Wednesdays & Saturdays 9 to 12). He said that he doesn't have anyone coming in on Sat. mornings and he thought this would be a good idea to have the clinic opened on Saturdays. Theresa asked about putting some kind of awning or something over the front door to keep the rain off the carpet and freezing. They are afraid someone will slip on ice on the steps, porch or ramp.
- 2-At 3 p.m. on 12-5-89 a Wayne's Feed Truck knocked down the stop sign at Eva when he made a right turn off 55W on to 35S, and didn't stop after knocking the sign down. Jr. Holmes, George Hudgins & David Childers put the sign back up. While the sign was down a car with a Jefferson County tag came through the 4way stop without even slowing down.
- 3-Clerk needs to send out notice of privilege licenses coming due; will have to buy extra postage.
