

Minutes of regular meeting of Eva Town Council held on December 10, 1992, at 7:00 p.m. Roll call by Mayor Ryan with Councilmen Fowler, Nichols, Alexander, Collins and Livingston present. Meeting opened with prayer by Mr. Nichols.

Motion by Mr. Collins, second by Mr. Fowler (carried) to approve November 12, 1992, minutes as written. Motion by Mr. Livingston second by Mr. Alexander (carried) to approve December 1, 1992, minutes as written.

Reports of Standing Committees:

a) Finance & Education:

1) Library Construction Update.

Sheetrock is up and ready for painting, trim and carpet. Council agreed to get Smoky Livingston to remove excess building supplies. Mr. Collins opened bids received on carpeting the Library. Eva Carpet bid \$849.00 and HomeTown Carpet bid \$728.00. Motion by Mr. Alexander, second by Mr. Livingston (carried with Mr. Fowler abstaining due to conflict of interest with HomeTown Carpet) for HomeTown Carpet to carpet the Library.

b) Utilities:

1) No update on the pending Joe Wheeler Lawsuit.

2) Stop Sign Update: Mr. Alexander spoke with Joe Summerford about obtaining the 3' stop signs. With a written request he will order what we need. The Painting of "Stop Ahead" will need to be done by a striping crew.

3) Old Town Hall Painting Update:

Mr. Alexander will handle the purchase of the paint at Hopper's when Tommy gets ready to begin painting.

4) Street Light Update: Mr. Alexander stated there are 5 street lights out and asked the Clerk to send a written letter to Joe Wheeler with the locations. In addition, John Smith asked for 2 street lights - 1 on Lindler Road and 1 across from the K.P. Morris homeplace. Council will consider this request when pricing has been obtained on the cost of the poles.

5) Mr. Alexander reported that the underbrush under the power lines across from Ruth Livingston's has been cleared.

c) Streets, Parks & Cemeteries:

1) Paving Update - Highway 55 has been patched and should be repaired within the next week. Mr. Fowler stated that Frost Backhoe hauled Rock for new road off of Childers Road.

He reported that Bobby Smith asked for assistance in repairing the drive to Fisherman's Catch. Council agreed to look into repairing the part that is on City Right-of-Way and will report back at next meeting.

2) Recreation Park - No update at present.

3) Industrial Park Update - meeting held at Fisherman's Catch with Industrial Board to review the possibility of building a spec. building to lease.

4) Update on Culvert at Highway 55 & Adams Road:
Afton stated more work is to be done with the possibility
of using asphalt to complete the project around the tiles.

d) Police & Fire:

Mr. Livingston stated bids are out for the new firetruck with
the opening to be December 28, at 3:00 p.m.

He is also working with someone to build the new tank at
a savings of around \$4,000.

e) Recreation & Sanitation

No new or updated items at this time.

No special committee reports at this time.

No information from Officers at this time.

Review of Financial Statement with a motion by Mr. Fowler,
second by Mr. Livingston (carried) to transfer funds and pay
bills as presented. Clerk also advised that financial records
are still at auditors.

Other Business:

- 1) Council reviewed request for light repair at the Senior Center
with Clerk advising that she will have the Senior Aide to
complete work as requested. Senior Center also requested an
additional garbage can rack and Council agreed if Senior Aide
cannot build this rack, to hire Ezra Drinkard to complete
request.

Motion to adjourn by Mr. Nichols, second by Mr. Collins (carried).
