

Minutes of the regular meeting of the Eva Town Council held on February 10, 2003, at 6:30 p.m. in the Eva Town Hall. Present: Mayor Gary Livingston, council members Burt Collins, C. C. Mosteller, Clarence Alexander, Brian Brown and Clerk Judy Fortenberry.

Guest: Lynn Gibbs with the Friends of the Eva Library, James Henderson, and Deputy Steve Campbell.

After roll call Mayor Livingston asked Mr. Collins to open the meeting with prayer.

Mr. Collins motion to dispense with reading of the minutes until after hearing from our guests, Mr. Mosteller seconded, motion carried.

Mayor Livingston thanked everyone for coming to the meeting and turned the meeting over to Mr. Gibbs with the Friends of the Eva Library. Mr. Gibbs brought the Council up on the programs planned at the Library for the coming year. Stated that the Friends were planning speakers to come once a month and give a short program on different issues that may interest the community. This past month had a speaker on the Civil War at Eva had 44 people to attend. This month they will offer a Driver Safety Program sponsored by AARP on February 25th from 12:00 noon to 4:00 p.m., at the Library. Class is limited to 50 and over. Also stated there are two positions that need to be filled in the Friends of the Library. Annual bake sale and membership drive is April 12, 2003.
