

Minutes of the Meeting of the Eva Town Council held in regular session on Feb. 14, 1980 at 7 p.m., attended by the Mayor and Councilmen Mobley, Livingston, Page and Morgan. The Mayor introduced Craig Beasley, the county staff writer for the Decatur Daily, who was a visitor to the meeting.

Minutes of the January meeting were read and approved. The financial report giving end-of-January totals was presented as follows:

A copy of the January financial report of receipts and expenditures was shown to all present.

The Mayor reported that the Alarm System has been purchased and is ready to be installed. He read to those present the Agreement between the Town of Eva and the Wheeler Basin Regional Library, which will be filed. In the first two weeks of operation, over 200 books were checked out.

The project of extending the city limits was discussed. Mr. Mobley said that the legislature meets for a short period soon, and unless they are called in a special session, we will not be able to get this done for 1980. It was decided to go ahead and get all the work done toward getting the extension. The Mayor said that after we get the maps completed we intend then to get our representative to introduce legislation to extend the city limits. This was in response to a question from Mr. Beasley.

The Mayor said that we need to find someone to replace former Councilman Jimmy Mosteller who has moved away.

The efforts of the Town of Eva to get a doctor was discussed. A new letter from UAB came in asking about our participation in the Physician's Opportunity Booklet and the Fair. The Mayor said that if and when we get a doctor we may have to get a working agreement with the Cullman Hospital to use their facilities since they are so much closer to us than those in Hartselle and Decatur. Mr. Mobley offered the motion, seconded by Mr. Page that we participate again this year and send the \$55 to UAB for the booklet. Motion carried. Mr. Page said that he would get a committee and start preparing material for the Fair to be held in September.

Bills were presented for payment as follows:

From Volunteer Fire Dept funds - Anniston Auto Parts for freight on alarm system \$25.69; National Butane \$36; 6 mos. premium on '77 fire truck \$220.80; Rural Fire Dept. Assn. dues \$10.

From General Fund - Petrolane gas for Sr. Citizens Center \$112.85; No. Ala. Mayor's Ass'n dues \$100; North Central Ala. Mental Health Center donation \$50; Water bill \$8.76; Electric Bill \$22.67; Phone bill \$46.59 less \$8.75 paid by Sr. Citizens; Clerk's Salary for January \$72.36; Roll of postage stamps \$15; UAB for Physician's Opportunity Booklet \$55.

From Gas Tax Fund - \$147.36 on the street light bill of \$1006.11.

Discussion followed that we need to publicize the existence of the Library. Mr. Mobley said that he'd have some posters made to put in the various businesses around in the community.

There being no further business, Mr. Livingston offered the motion, seconded by Mr. Page that the meeting be adjourned.
