

Minutes of Meeting of Eva Town Council held in regular session at 7 p.m. February 14, 1985, attended by Mayor Ryan and all 5 councilmen. Minutes of the January 10 meeting were read and approved. Financial report was presented, giving the following balances:

Old Business:

- 1-Terrell hasn't had an opportunity to talk to the fellow who might be able to do the repairs on the cracks in the Fire Hall and Bathroom.
- 2-There's no new word on the Library Grant
- 3-The Mayor and Mr. Nichols (Council President) will try to go to Decatur next week to begin actions on extending the city limits by taking in an additional 940 acres (Reference Minutes of Call Meeting on June 23, 1984.). In the meantime the Clerk will call Ala. League of Municipalities to ask what steps are necessary to complete the extending of city limits.
- 4-Clerk reported on her discussion with License Office at the Morgan County Courthouse regarding tags for the fire trucks. Mr. Nichols offered the motion, seconded by Mr. Morgan to get the trucks titled and tags for them. Motion carried.
- 5-No further word on the cafe in Eva. The Perk test has been done.
- 6-The Volunteer Firemen will put the flag pole up as soon as weather permits and several can be available to do the job.

New Business:

- 1-The Town Council adopted the proposed 1985 budget after amending it to include \$8,000 land payment and \$3420 interest payments. Budget proposed included \$67,620 from General Fund, \$7,871 from Volunteer Fire Department and \$1,585 from Gasoline Tax Fund for a total of \$77,076.00.
- 2-Council voted to have the Clerk fill out the application for Surplus Property and discussed names of individuals to be put on the listing as authorized to select items for Town of Eva.
- 3-Clerk was authorized to pay the 1984 tax due on the former Valley Oil property.
- 4-Clerk reported that she was asked by Doris Ridgeway in Decatur to be sworn in as a Deputy Registrar for registering people to vote. Clerk will go to Ridgeway's office at first opportunity to be sworn in, and to get procedures for registering.
- 5-Mr. Nichols offered the motion, seconded by Mr. Hipps to pay the bills as presented, which were: General Fund.
