

Minutes of Meeting of Eva Town Council held in regular session on February 13, 1986, at 7 PM, attended by Mayor Ryan, Terrell Livingston, Ray Morgan and Alton Page. Kermit Morris was a guest. (Charles Nichols was sick; Mitchell Higgs at funeral home w/relatives)

Mayor called on Kermit Morris who said that he would like to rent the property on the corner where the old cafe was, from April through June or perhaps longer, to sell plants while they are in bloom. He said that he would need some type structure to house the plants over night, and for a sales person to use. The building would be in compliance with the town council's requirements. He said that it would need to be anchored down so that it couldn't be moved by vandals. He had permission from Joe Estes to use his bathroom facilities. Mayor told him that the council would discuss it and let him know something this weekend, since he said that he wanted to be opened prior to Easter. After Kermit left the meeting, the council voted to let him have that corner for the 3 months specified, @ \$10 per month, with an option to continue the arrangement if he wished. Old Business: construction

Mayor reported that all the library bills had been paid and the carpet installed. The legal description of the property to be annexed to Town of Eva was corrected, and the Clerk is now working on getting property owners' signatures.

New Business:

- Council Adopted (1) Resolution to name the new structure the Eva Public Library.
(2) Resolution to make a grant application to the Alabama Public Library Service for \$5,000 to complete furnishing the Library.
(3) Budget for Calendar Year 1986. (copies of all attached for the record)
- Senior Citizens Building Site was discussed. The place that was graded off will not be large enough to accommodate the building and required parking spaces. Mayor said that the Council members needed to go back up there to decide on another location for the building and get it ready.
 - Discussed Mayor's Meeting in Huntsville next Thursday night at which Billy Joe Camp is guest speaker. No one committed to attend.
 - In next letter to Joe Wheeler tell them that the 3rd light on the left *in front of the furniture store* is out.
 - Council voted to change the Revenue Sharing account from a regular checking account to an interest-bearing account since the funds have been committed to Parks & Recreation and we are not yet ready to be spending money in that area. (Resolution passed; copy attached).
 - Voted to pay the bills as presented, which were: (M: Livingston; S: Page)

From VFD Acct-truck insurance \$1299.62; CAL-GAS \$210; Ash-McNeil (oxygen) \$6; NAFECO \$72.50; 2 radio repairs \$34.50; Joe's Texaco for batteries, repairs \$150.10; B&M truck gas \$20.10; Eva's share on county truck \$30. From Gas Tax Fund Street lights \$141.48; rocks for city streets \$72.85; metal pipe \$1226.48. Motion included authorization to transfer funds as required.

There being no further business, Mr. Page offered the motion, seconded by Mr. Morgan to adjourn the meeting.
