

Minutes of Meeting of Eva Town Council held in regular session January 8, 1987, at 7 p.m., attended by Mayor Ryan and all 5 councilmen. Minutes of the December 16 meeting were read and approved.

Mayor called on the spokesman for a group of local residents who wished to bring an issue before the Council. Some residents voiced concerns about the plans for some chicken houses to be built in their neighborhood; asked the Council whether the town had an ordinance prohibiting this; also whether there would be any zoning done. The Mayor gave them a negative reply to both questions, saying that the council had no plans for zoning or establishing a zoning board.

Old Business:

- 1-Clerk is still working on the restructuring of a sewer grant request.
- 2-Mayor hasn't talked yet with Joe Summerford about the stop signs.
- 3-Mayor said that their truck had broken down and that they had not had the opportunity to pick up the chairs for the Multipurpose Center in Decatur.
- 4-Mayor talked with Benny Childers about fixing the doors at the Center.
- 5-We should be hearing from the Library Grant soon, for installing septic tank at Library.
- 6-Talked with Williams Surveying Co. about the problem on the property lines (number of feet shown on their survey sheet) on the property to be sold to Chaffins.
- 7-Mr. Doyle has not contacted the Mayor yet about the information we need on the fire hydrants for the newly annexed areas.
- 8-Mr. Hipps said that Joe Wheeler needs to come out again to fix the street light in front of Laura Hipps, Highway 35 North.

New Business:

- 1-Clerk reported that the Audit of the Town's records was completed and no discrepancies were found. After looking over the audit report, the Mayor asked to have the report amended to include the Certificate of Deposit. Clerk will arrange this with the auditor.
- 2-Clerk reported that Privilege Licenses notices have been mailed out.
- 3-Mayor told of the visit of Pat Higdon, Hartselle Medical Center and Optometrist, Dr. Smith (?). The doctor said that they had some equipment that wasn't being utilized and wanted to know if they could move it to Eva and have an optometrist come out a certain number of days a week to take care of the people in this area. Mayor told them to go back to discuss this with the Hartselle Medical Center to see what kind of an agreement they could come up with; then report back to us. I told them that we might be able to come up with a location for them if we can work out some type of agreement with the hospital.
- 4-Mayor told of the reply from ISO, saying that we were in line for a new survey of the Volunteer Fire Department, but we still have a lot of paper work to do. He said that if we could get even one grade improvement it would help out on the homeowners' insurance for the community residents.
- 5-Mayor announced that the next North Ala. Mayors Meeting would be on Jan. 15 at the Carriage Inn in Huntsville.

In Other Actions, the Council voted to:

- 1-Subscribe to THE EVA GAZETTE for the Library @ \$8.00/year.
- 2-Authorize Clerk to get Mrs. Poole to clean Town Hall and Library (M: Hipps; S: Livingston).
- 3-Pay the bills totaling \$4,456.18, as follows: (M: Page; S: Livingston)
