Old Business:

- ✓ 1-Signs. Decide what is needed; get Bob Woodruff to write specs; order; reimburse county.
- ✓ 2-Outside Sign for Town/Fire Dept. use. Donald Ray could not build the sign; said to check on other sources. Holaway's Signs at Flint gave these quotes:
 Lighted sign, with arrow, bulbs, box of letters; delivered and set up - \$270. (his cost)
 No name printed on it. He buys these in lot amounts. Cost would be the same for unlighted sign; also for one without arrow because this would be custom design.
 Robinson's Quality Signs - Letter Board (no arrow) - \$290

- 1-Town of Eva hosting Morgan County Mayors/Clerks meeting Monday night, Jan. 18, 6:30 PM at Bobby's Fisherman's Catch. Need to know how many of Council Members will be going. Tentative acceptance received from Tom & Chris Drake; Don & Verna Hale.
- 2-Fire Chief wants authorization to order from E.V. Fire Equipment Company some rust inhibitor and lubricant at a cost of \$329. They drained the truck tanks recently and the tank protector purchased from Bidall is NOT doing the job. The tanks have some pitting and had some scaling and rusting. The E.V. Fire Equipment Co. says that their product is designed to keep tanks from pitting, scaling and rusting. Chief said NOT to buy from Bidall again (tank protector stuff). EV's product is called Rust Buster.
- 3-Need official authorization from Council to have exercise classes at the Center on Tues. and Thurs. from 1:30 to 2:30 (per discussion with Mayor and Ruth). Shannon Stinson with Morgan County Parks & Recreation will be the instructor; no charge. So far about 12 women have said they want to take the classes.
