

Eva Town Council Meeting January 12, 1989, 7 p.m.

Old Business

- 1-Park status (Eddleman)
- 2-Highway signs (Woodruff)
- 3-Water Line on West Side. Any word from Mr. Hicks on help from County?
- 4-Any word from Don Hale on appointment in Birmingham about mail routes?
- 5-Medical Clinic Status.
- 6-Sign at Senior Center. Clerk needs information on whether to get a 3x5' or 4x6' double-face sign. Larry's Signs will make the sign, and will build the posts into the frame, since there will be lettering on both sides. Cost for a 3'x5' would be \$365; a 4'x6' would be \$450. It would take about 2 weeks. Suggested lettering same: EVA NUTRITION SITE AND COMMUNITY CENTER. Council voted to pay half; Center pay half. Size of sign would determine landscaping layout. I know Kermit and Charles. Who is Bobby?
- 7-Was it definitely decided that we did not need parking lot bumpers? *no - we need the ones on west side*
- 8-Did Arvol Allison report on the State Laws for discharging of firearms in city limits?

New Business

- 1-Appoint 3 members to Industrial Development Board to serve a 6-year term (1994) replacing Bert Collins, J.C. Miner and Jasper Jones.
- 2-Appoint a councilman to fill unexpired term of Mitchell Hipps.
- 3-Fire Chief asks if the Council will authorize the purchase of 2 more uniforms for his newest 2 active members who are answering fire calls. They are William Chaffin and Thomas Drinkard. They also attend meetings regularly. Cost for a complete uniform (jacket, shirt, pants, cap and badge) would be \$143.90. Battles said they would let us have them at same price he gave us on the others last year.
- 4-William Neal (I&N Electric) said we should look into how we might be able to get the county tax money that is now going to Falkville since he is on a Falkville route. He has no retail sales in his business, but purchases aprx \$250,000 worth of equipment. Right now 4% of the tax he pays on this goes to the state and 3% to the City of Falkville.
- 5-NARCOG has offered to assist Town of Eva with a CDBG grant request. This money is set aside for improvements. Nora Landers is in Montgomery this week. She thinks a sewer system project would fall under CDBG's guidelines for "improvements." She will contact the Mayor or the Clerk upon her return and set up a time to meet with us.
