

Minutes of Meeting of Eva Town Council held in Regular Session July 14, 1983, at 7 p.m. attended by Mayor Ryan and all five members of the Council. Minutes of the June 9 meeting were read and approved. Financial report was received, giving the following balances:

Old Business:

The Mayor reported the following-

- 1-The Attorney General says that the Town of Eva cannot purchase the Livingston Land.
- 2-On the protest of the property survey, we haven't heard from Rex Williams in writing but he told me that he would stand behind his survey. He said that Dr. Morgan had been down there twice with two different deeds, but Rex is still of the opinion that he is right. Our lawyer responded that there is a possibility that an error could be made by the surveyor, just as it was possible for anyone else to make one. He said that he would take the case if we wanted to pursue the matter. The Council voted to turn our deeds and survey information over to the lawyer and let him handle the matter. Perhaps he could call Curtis and Marie in and talk it over with them.
- 3-Sewing industry expansion. Both Dwight and Vonda are interested in expanding; Dwight is putting in two more machines and he is now working 10 people. The ADO people have not told us yet just how they will be able to help with this, but we need to get in touch with them.
- 4-Health Clinic Addition. Charles Frost has gone to Georgia to get the lead paneling. Upon his return, he will be asked to give us a completion date for remodeling the addition so that the hospital can make plans as to supplying the lab and hiring the extra person.
- 5-A&GS has been out to put more Kool Seal on the trailer-roof connection. It hasn't rained yet, so they don't know for sure whether the leaks have been completely stopped.
- 6-Eva Cemetery. Mayor will see Monte & Winford Morgan next weekend and ask them about the land joining the cemetery.
- 7-The County approved changing the name from Lizzie Street to Lindler Street. Joe S. said he would take care of getting new signs up.
- 8-Gas in the ditch. Joe Holmes checked his tanks and he is not missing any gas at Eva Four-Way. He must have talked to them about rinsing out gas cans because the gas is now gone out of the ditch.
- 9-Joe Summerford said that they would fix that place between the Eva Methodist Church and Mrs. Harper's so that J.D. will be able to mow it. He will also fix the grills.
- 10-The Sheriff responded that they have drafted a bill and presented it to Gary Aldridge who told him that a number of these bills would be introduced in February. Mayor called Steve Cooley who said that Gary should be the one to introduce it. We need to talk to Gary about trying to do this before February. Word was left for him to call the Mayor but he has not done so yet.
- 11-The Clerk replied to the Petroleum Council request.

New Business:

- 1-On the June RRR gas tax disbursement, the County Clerk sent us \$338.87. We got a letter from her saying that this was in error; our allocation should have been \$56.26; she wanted us to reimburse the Morgan County RRR Gasoline Fund for the difference, which is \$282.61. Mr. Nichols offered motion, seconded by Mr. Livingston that we send the County a check for that amount. Motion carried.

New business, continued:

- 2-Mayor reported to the Council that on July 30 the Town Council is to be honored guests at the Eva Alumni Meeting at the School. Clerk said that the Council Members and their wives are to be guests of the Alumni Association for the dinner. All Council Members are planning to be present, with their wives except Ray's wife is unable to go.
- 3-Jerry Mobley told the Council that this would probably be his last meeting since he will be moving to Baton Rouge, LA. He said that he would send in his letter of resignation. He said that he had enjoyed serving on the Council and that he hopes all the best for the Town of Eva and the community.
- 4-Ray Morgan said that he would like to see the Town of Eva get a flag pole and a flag for Town Hall; and offered a motion to this effect. Mr. Nichols seconded the motion, which carried. Mayor said that we need to get an all-weather flag since we would leave it flying at all times.
- 5-Mr. Nichols said that he would like to see us get the former Eva 66 place, and the one on the corner owned by Enos Franks cleaned up. It was decided that the Council would try again to buy the Franks property. Motion was offered by Mr. Mobley, seconded by Mr. Nichols to write a letter to Mr. Franks offering him \$8,000 for the property. Motion carried.
- 6-Mr. Nichols offered the motion, seconded by Mr. Hipps to pay the bills for this month which were presented as follows:
General Fund - Office supplies \$17.45; water bill \$8.58; net phone bill \$44.74;
Clerk's salary for June \$134.76; Electric bills not yet in for Town Hall aprx. \$25; for Senior Citizens Center aprx. \$50.
Gasoline Tax Fund - Street lights aprx. \$127.
Volunteer Fire Dept. - 6 mos. premium on 1977 Chevrolet truck \$230.30.

There being no further business, Mr. Mobley offered the motion, seconded by Mr. Hipps that the meeting be adjourned.
