

Minutes of the regular meeting of the Eva Town Council held on July 9, 2002, at 6:30 p.m. in the Eva Town Hall. Present: Mayor Gary Livingston, council members Burt Collins, C. C. Mosteller, Clarence Alexander, Kent Chambers, Brian Brown and Clerk Judy Fortenberry. Mr. Mosteller was late arriving.

After roll call Mayor Livingston asked Mr. Collins to open the meeting with prayer.

Mr. Chambers motion to dispense with reading of the minutes until after hearing from our guest, Mr. Alexander second, carried.

Mayor Livingston thanked everyone for coming to the meeting and turned the meeting over to the ladies with the Art Guild. Ms Weaver stated their purpose in attending the meeting was to see what support they could get from the Town of Eva for this year Frontier Days. Also asked the Mayor if they could move the Bluegrass Festival to the Ball Park – Mayor and Council Members had no problem with moving the Festival from the School to the Ball park a tent will be used in the middle ball field, money taken at the gate. Mayor stated that he felt the Art Guild should support the Antique Tractor Show with a tent this year. After discussion was decided to have Art Guild at the work session on Frontier Days. Art Guild left the meeting at 7:45 p.m..

Mayor thanked Mr. Drake for coming to the meeting and explained to Council Members that Mr. Drake was presenting the Audit for 2000-2001. Mr. Drake went over the audit page by page and commended the Council for the job they do in handling the Town's funds. Mr. Drake and Heath left the meeting at 7:25 p.m..

Mayor Livingston asked if everyone had read minutes of June 11, 2002 regular council meeting. Mr. Collins motion to approve, Mr. Brown second, carried.

A. FINANCE & EDUCATION - MR. MOSTELLER

Mr. Mosteller reported that CD #'s5868 Eva Bank and 40521 First Commercial Bank had been renewed at the best interest rate.

Mr. Mosteller reported the icemaker at the Center is needing some repair, and that it is not large enough when fund raiser are held. Mayor suggested that we check with the State Surplus Store and see if they can locate one for us. Clerk will check on this.

B. UTILITIES – MR. ALEXANDER

Mr. Alexander reported water leak on Gravel Ridge Road, near Leon Mosteller drive had been repaired. Also reported that a 6" water line would be installed on Patton Road, requiring two additional fire hydrants. Mr. Collins will get Emern Holmes to make locations for Fire Hydrants.

C. STREETS, PARKS, & CEMETERIES - MR. BROWN

Mr. Brown reported:

Crape myrtle has been cut down at Childers Building.

Tennis net replaced with a metal one, and all basketball chains have been replaced. Tennis net poles need to be reset; they are bowing to the inside. Council discussed the surface of the court and decided to get in touch with someone that does asphalt.

Need backpack sprayer for round up at the park, Clerk will check at State Surplus Store.

L&N Electric has completed the work at the park on the lights.

Council discussed Eva Road School bill for paving. Mr. Brown motioned to pay bill to County Commission, Mr. Collins second, carried.

Lindler road and Mr. Collins ditch needs additional work.

D. POLICE & FIRE – MR CHAMBERS

Mr. Chambers report that we had 1 EMT calls, and 1 fire calls this past month. Fire Prevention Program working.

Mr. Chambers reported that he has a meeting with Sheriff McBride at the end of the month.

E. RECREATION & SANITATION – MR. COLLINS

Mr. Collins reported that the Town had received a letter from Shelby and Aderholt concerning our request for funding for the sewer.
