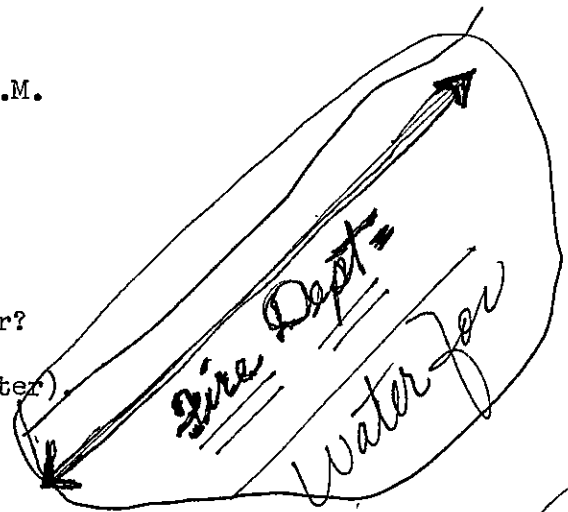


AGENDA - EVA TOWN COUNCIL MEETING - JULY 14, 1988, 7 P.M.

New Business
