

Minutes of the Meeting of the Eva Town Council held in regular session on June 12, 1980, at 7 p.m., with the Mayor and Councilmen Mobley, Livingston and Morgan attending.

Minutes of the May meeting were read and approved. The financial report was given, showing end-of-May balance as follows:

The reply to the paper from the Morgan County Commission regarding the 2% tax was discussed. Mr. Mobley offered the motion, seconded by Mr. Morgan, that we answer it in the form recommended by Mr. Cooley. Motion carried.

Mr. Livingston offered the motion, seconded by Mr. Mobley that we transfer \$150 out of the general fund to the gas tax fund to pay on the street light bill. Motion carried.

Mr. Morgan offered the motion, seconded by Mr. Livingston, to pay the following bills:

Birlen Childers had told the Mayor that he needed more rent at the Saddle Club Bldg. This item was tabled after the request was presented from Birlen to increase the rent to \$125 per month, with motion to table being offered by Mr. Mobley; seconded by Mr. Morgan, to table it until next meeting to study this a bit further.

Mr. Mobley offered the motion that we ask Mr. Jones with the help of the trustees to present to the Council what the 1980-81 budget is and to prepare a recommendation to the Council on how the Town of Eva could help on this educational budget. Motion seconded by Mr. Livingston, carried. A letter will be prepared to send to Mr. Jones. It was voted to add this item of Education under Place #1 under Finance.

The Clerk reported to the Council that the following qualified:

Incumbents Roland Ryan for Mayor
K. J. Mobley for Place #1
Terrell Livingston for Place #2
Mitchell Hipps for Place #4
Donald Ray Morgan for Place #5.

Incumbent Alton Page did not wish to seek reelection to Place #3, and there was no one who qualified for this Place. Council passed a resolution to declare those elected.

There being no further business, Mr. Livingston offered the motion that the meeting be adjourned.
