

Minutes of the regular meeting of the Eva Town Council held on June 8, 2010, 6:30 p.m. at the Eva Town Hall. Present: Mayor Gary Livingston, Councilmember's: Jim Henderson, Johnny Persall, Kent Chambers and Clerk Judy Fortenberry. Councilmember's Collins and Shadden out of Town...

Guests: Joe Hill, John Holmes, Betty Golden.

Mayor called the meeting to order; all council members present except Mr. Collins and Mr. Shadden. After roll call, informed all present that we open our meetings with prayer, if anyone objected we would abstain from this practice at tonight's meeting. No one objected, Mayor asked Mr. Henderson to open with prayer.

Mayor asked if everyone had read the minutes of the May 11, 2010 regular Council Meeting. Council member Henderson motion to approve the minutes, Council member Persall seconded, carried.

A: FINANCE, EDUCATION & LIBRARY- MR. CHAMBERS

Councilmember Chambers recognized Ms. Golden with the Library and commended her on the "Summer Reading Program". MS Golden reported attendance for the program was 79 total with ten older children and some of the 79 were parents, but not sure of the numbers at this time. She is hopeful that more will attend in the following weeks. Next week the Petting Zoo will be there and that's a program all the children look forward to.

Councilmember Chambers reported that Senator Orr and Represented Oden were at the Library on June 3, to present the check for the lights.

Work session for the budget is scheduled for June 28, at 4:30 p.m. to review this year's budget.

Due to the Run-off Election on July 13, the Council decided to meet on July 7, at 6:30 p.m. for the July Regular Council Meeting.

B: UTILITIES & STREETS- MR. SHADDEN

Mayor reported he had talked with Mr. Stisher about the money for paving Highway 55, but still no money.

C: PARKS, RECREATION & CEMETERIES - MR. PERSALL

Councilmember Persall reported he had talked with the county about the clean up of the Livingston property, Roger had stated if we had a place to put the stumps maybe they could clean the area, and burn the stumps at another location. He also stated that he had talked with Tommy Mccaghren about helping with this work at no charge. Mayor stated that we could give him a receipt for in-kind-services if he did do the work.

D: POLICE, FIRE & GRANTS - MR HENDERSON

Councilmember Henderson reported he had CDG Engineering back to look at the sidewalk located in front of the old furniture store where the water is running over the sidewalk. CDG

stated there was nothing that can be done at this location unless we want to tear up the sidewalk and fill the area then replace the sidewalk. All agree that this did not need to be done.

F: SANITATION & BUILDINGS –MR. COLLINS

Mayor asked Mr. Hill about the progress on the sewer project. Mr. Hill stated that work has pick-up and they are coming along slow but doing a good job.

Mr. Hill also reported that the problem at the school had been solved, seems there is a spring in the old lunch room basement, and the pump was tied into the sewer lines. This problem has been addressed and hopefully solve. He also stated that Andrew Crawford would warrant the pumps that needed to be extended.

Councilmember Henderson reported on the doctors at the Medical Clinic, and hopefully they will be staffed within the next week or so.

Councilmember Henderson also, stated that he would talk with the Deputy about the traffic at the four-way, needs to be slowed done, because of the children in town.


Old Business: Mayor Livingston stated he would look over the Boards and appoint at the next Regular Council Meeting.
