

Minutes of the regular meeting of the Eva Town Council held on June 10, 2014, 6:30 p.m. at the Eva Town Hall. Present: Mayor Livingston, council members Jim Henderson, Johnny Persall, Martin Nelson, and Clerk Judy Fortenberry. Kent Chambers and Brandlee Shadden were absent due to work commitments.

Guests: Joe Hill, John Holmes, Deputy Ripley Fowler, Betty Golden and David Estes-Eva School Principal

Mayor called the meeting to order; Mayor Livingston, council members: Jim Henderson, Johnny Persall, Martin Nelson and Clerk Judy Fortenberry in attendance. After roll call, informed all present that we open our meetings with prayer, if anyone objected we would abstain from this practice at tonight's meeting. No one objected, Mayor asked Mr. Henderson to open with prayer.

Mayor asked if everyone had read the minutes of the May 13, 2014 regular Council Meeting. Mr. Henderson motion to approve the minutes, Mr. Persall seconded, carried.

### **A: FINANCE, EDUCATION & LIBRARY– MR. CHAMBERS**

Mayor presented the Revised Budgets for the following accounts: General Fund, Sewer and Library, as revised in the work session.

Mr. Persall motion to accept the budges as presented, Mr. Henderson seconded, carried.

Mayors welcome Mr. Estes to the meeting and ask him if he had anything to bring before the Council. Mr. Estes stated he would like to use one of the water meters at the school to water the football field, and not have to pay sewer fees. All agreed that would be acceptable. Mayor told him to let Cullman County Water know which meter, they would call this office and we would approve.

Mr. Estes also stated that the money the Town gave the school had been used to purchase security cameras and a fence as requested.

Mr. Nelson asked about the fund raisers which the school has, Mr. Estes is willing to work with the community to cut down on the number of fund raisers.

### **B: UTILITIES & STREETS– MR. SHADDEN**

Mayor reported the letter received by the Town to remove our "Welcome to Eva" sign from the right of way. Stated Eva Bank was protesting the request and the County is looking into this request. Hopefully the signs will not have to be removed.

### **C: PARKS, RECREATION & CEMETERIES – MR. PERSALL**

Mr. Persall reported he has a price for the pipe requested for the ball park. Can get the pipe from Hoppers for \$170 for 15", will cost about \$1700. Mayor stated we can get dirt for the pipe when we do the storm shelters. Also stated he would call Stisher and get on the list for sand for the playground.

Mr. Persall asked about the yard sale was agreed to have it on July 18-19, at the Veterans Memorial Park, no charge to participants. Will put sign up at 4-way on fence, at the Veterans

park and on Facebook.

**D: POLICE, FIRE & GRANTS – MR HENDERSON**

Mr. Henderson ask if we were going to do anything about the ordinance on the building in Town, Mayor said he had talked with Mike Hopper about the house and he was going to get Fairview to burn the house, if we didn't have a problem with them doing it. All agreed to let them burn the house.

**F: SANITATION & BUILDINGS –MR. NELSON**

Mr. Nelson asks if we could get Mike Caudle to build the shed and pour the pad at the Sewer Plant, all agreed. He will contact Mr. Caudle.
