- Explained storm damage of Sewer trailer and requested three bids to put metal over roofing and wants council approval to repair. Mayor requested a motion to repair Sewer trailer roof with metal. - Shared regarding Sanders Road bridge project, Stephen Dorsett from Vortec, Inc and another engineer from Texas will be in touch this week to discuss repair guidance. Mayor will ask Commissioner Stisher to help and will ask state for fifty percent of paving cost.
- Stated to adopt Morgan County regulations for Jeff Frost's subdivision, Town must have planning and zoning commission per Town attorney Larry Madison. Mayor said Town can take over 1800 total linear feet of subdivision streets with one year warranty provided by Jeff Frost

either now or after completion. Vote to be taken at Special Meeting.

- Said Town would present an updated sewer ordinance next regular meeting.
- Recognized Amber and Clint Baker who stated they could not get utilities for new building until sewer connections are made.
- Mentioned three new flagpoles have been ordered for Veteran's Park-two twenties and one twenty-five. Asked Charles Stephens to check on prices for park statues.
