Chief Holmes with proposed budget for 1990-91 for Eva VFD.

Old Business:

1-Recreation Park Status:

- a. Mayor & Terry Childers met with Richard Smith from TVA (Muscle Shoals) at the park to discuss lighting at the park. He is to furnish a layout proposal.
- b. Walking trail work completed today with Hooten doing a little more work than was in the original bid. County contributed \$15,400 In-Kind work.
- c. Metro Systems was supposed to have a representative meet with Mayor and Terry Childers on Friday at 12 about water supply at Park, but the rep did not show up.

2-Decision on options of fixing leak at Dental Clinic?

3-Bill Nelson repaired water leak in Women's Restroom at T.Hall.

4-Ordinance on Tractor Trailers parking in Eva. Need more time to review?

5-Portable toilets for Frontier Days.

New Business:

1-Mayor sent letter to Mayor BillDukes concerning changes proposed for the land fill. (Use caution; if there is increase in fees, excess should be put in escrow until all directives are in place.)

2-Sign papers required for grant on walking trail; recommend Mayor, Chairman pro tem of Council and Town Clerk. The latter two also needs to sign cards at the bank.

3-Premiere Cable (Mark Berry) is giving free cable service for Eva Town Hall/Fire Hall. Letter of appreciation was sent.

4-Items for decision on whether to include in Town's Budget.

- a. Request from Eva School listed in priority order (sheet)
- b. Request from Wheeler Basin for \$1500 for new books at Eva Library. See proposal, which includes statistics.
- c. Request from North Central Alabama Mental Health Board for \$165 this year.
- d. Pro rata share of financial contribution by North Alabama Mayor's Association on The Tennessee Valley Interstate Economic Development Corridor - \$25.00

5-Census info received from Atlanta says Town of Eva has population (from 1990 census figures) of 366. Our census info submitted was aprx. 450. Do you want to challenge the 366 figure, or let it stand? If so, you have to appeal on group quarters (a recount of a specific section), rather than the total population. Appeal/Challenge has to be submitted by Sept. 30.
