

Minutes of Meeting of Eva Town Council held in regular session September 8, 1988, at 7 PM, attended by Mayor Ryan and all five members of the Council. Darrell Eddleman attended as representative of the Eva Activities Association. Also attending were newly elected council members Bert Collins and Gary Livingston, who will take office on October 3. Meeting was opened with prayer by the Mayor.

Minutes of the August 11 regular meeting and the call meetings of August 23, 25 and September 2 were read and approved. Motion was made by Mr. Livingston, s: Mr. Page; carried to allow Darrell Eddleman to speak to the council before continuing with other business of the council. Motion carried.

Mayor told the Council that he had checked with NARCOG who said to go ahead with the survey; that this would not interfere with our grant request. He passed this word on earlier to Mr. Eddleman. Mr. Eddleman said that the crew chief for Owens Surveyors has been ill with pneumonia and that's why they haven't been out already. He said that they plan to do the work next week. Date of Sept. 22 was set for next meeting to discuss status of park development plans, at 7 PM, and Mr. Eddleman left the meeting.

Old Business:

- 1-No word from the county engineer on the highway signs; no word on the mail routes.
- 2-The driveway extension for ROJO Mfg. Co. was completed to their satisfaction.
- 3-Mayor asked Councilmen Morgan and Livingston to go talk to the residents involved in the road/driveway situation at Stacy's property line.
- 4-The culvert between the school and Mr. Nichols has been cleaned out; the culverts at Eva Tire Co., and the Eva Church of Christ have been installed.
- 5-Clerk reported that she still has not had time to check on the overdue book situation.
- 6-Clerk reported that she had received the \$9 check back from the Government Book Store, saying that the 1988 zip code directory had gone up to \$13. Council voted to wait and order a 1989 directory when they come out, since it is now so late in the year.

New Business:

- 1-Council looked over the proposed agreement between Town of Eva and National Health Care, Inc., d/b/a Hartselle Medical Center; made several suggested changes. Clerk is to re-type the proposed agreement to incorporate these changes. Council adopted a resolution authorizing the Mayor to execute the agreement with NHI/HMC. (M:Page; S:Morgan; c
- 2-Discussed budget preparation and need to include \$20,000 for street repairs; decided to have a separate budget session in October. Tabled School's request until that time.
- 3-Discussed a question that has come up about Town of Eva possibly giving monetary support to Brewer School. Mayor said that this would not be legal according to the Alabama Code which says that the school must be within the corporate limits of the municipality giving the monetary support. Council did say that they would be willing to match support by Somerville and Priceville if a way is worked out that such support could be given.
- 4-Jerry Harrison, Chairman of GROW for Morgan County, is going before the County Commission on Mon., Sept. 12, 10 AM, to urge the county to enforce litter laws. With ALABAMA REUNION in 1989, the state is hoping to have a beautiful and clean state. Mr. Harrison wants as much support at this meeting as possible, and the Council members were invited to attend. Eva Community Pride Chairperson Kermit Morris plans to attend and maybe Conard Self.
- 5-Larry McDearmond has done all the caulking around windows and doors at the Library; has put on one coat of the latex stain. He will also paint the letters, around the windows, trim, and entrance way. His bill is the following: Labor & paint (2 coats) per his original bid \$460; extra caulking, painting letters, trim, etc., \$65, for total of \$525. He does not want pay until job is finished. Council voted to have clerk pay him when the job is finished so that he doesn't have to wait another month for his check. (M:Hipp; S:Morgan; carried).

- 6-Discussed the Mayor talking to Sheriff Burgess to get the deputies to be more conscientious about problems in the Eva area. He said that he would do so.
- 7-Discussed the possibility of painting across the highways STOP AHEAD to possibly help in avoiding accidents at the 4-way intersection, since drivers seem to be overlooking the "Stop Ahead" signs. Mayor will check into this to find out about what such a project would cost.

In OTHER ACTIONS the Council voted to:

- 1-Adopt a resolution authorizing the Mayor to enter an agreement between the Town of Eva and the Alabama League of Municipalities to get their assistance in the collection of delinquent insurance license tax payments owed to the Town (M:Nichols; S:Hipps; carried)
A copy of the resolution 88-16 is attached.
- 2-Have a barbecue supper for the Eva Volunteer Fire Department members and their families and the Eva Library volunteers and their families. (M:Hipps; S:Nichols; carried).
A date of Oct. 15, 6:30 p.m. was proposed for the Eva VFD consideration.
- 3-Accept bid of Eva Nurseries in amount of \$1,229.30 for landscaping job at Eva Library;
accept bid of Eva Nurseries in amount of \$ 854.20 for landscaping job at lot/Texaco bank;
accept bid of Eva Nurseries in amount of \$1,923.20 for landscaping job at Medical Clinic;
accept bid of C.E. Ford & Son in amount of \$2,461.50 for landscaping at Grammar School;
accept bid of C.E. Ford & Son in amount of \$1,120.50 for landscaping at School Lunchroom;
accept bid of C.E. Ford & Son in amount of \$1,997.00 for landscaping project behind the junior high school building, Eva School. (M:Livingston; S:Page; carried)
- 4-Pay the bills as presented on attached sheet, and to transfer funds as required.
(M:Morgan; S:Hipps; carried.)

There being no further business, motion offered by Mr. Page, seconded by Mr. Nichols to adjourn.
