

Minutes of Call Meeting of Eva Town Council held September 25, 1986 at 7 p.m., attended by Mayor and Councilmen Nichols, Livingston and Hipps. Both Councilmen Morgan and Page were ill.

Mayor announced that the main purpose of the call meeting was to finish our land transaction with David Chaffin, Ordinance 86.2 was published in The Hartselle Enquirer on September 25. We need to give Mr. Chaffin a copy of the platte and Ordinance to give to the people who is to lend him the money. Motion was made by Mr. Nichols, seconded by Mr. Livingston to go ahead with the procedures necessary to get the transaction finalized. Clerk will take it up with Mr. Chaffin and if he wants us to have the deeds prepared, will take the information to Mr. Powell to get the deeds written up.

Other items of business transacted were:

- 1-Mr. Paden, architect/engineer over the Multi-Purpose Center construction, has given final inspection and said that the senior citizens can move their nutrition site into it now.
- 2-Bill presented for payment which needs to be paid before our next regular meeting was from Terrell Enterprises for \$5,077 for the new shades at Eva School. (M: Nichols; S:Hipps; carried)
- 3-Bids were presented on the office blinds (\$374), the curtains for elementary library (\$315) and the desks for science classroom (\$1545) for Eva School. Council voted to have Mr. Jones proceed with the purchase of these items, to be billed to Eva Town Council.
- 4-Voted to get Town Hall and Library cleaned next week.
- 5-Authorized Mitchell Hipps to buy brooms and mops for the new building and to present the bill for reimbursement to Town Council.
- 6-Discussed planned visit of Dee Proctor and Earl Morris of Morgan County Industrial Development Board for luncheon meeting at Bobby's on October 7. Mayor told members of the Council who were available to attend this. He is inviting others from the area such as Mike Fite, Jack Hopper, Gwinn Mason, Birlen Childers, Cleo Alexander, etc. The proposal for establishing an industrial development board for Eva will be discussed at a special meeting to be held at the new building on Thursday night, Oct. 2, at 7. Mayor and Clerk will invite the people. All council members are invited.
- 7-At the proposal of Mr. Livingston, Council voted to give the Clerk a raise from \$6 an hour to \$8 an hour beginning Oct. 1. (M: Livingston; S:Nichols; carried)
- 8-Per Council's decision at meeting on 10-17-85, Clerk should now transfer accounts to Eva Bank. Mr. Nichols offered the motion, seconded by Mr. Hipps to adjourn. (Cy Res. 86-3 attached.)
