

Minutes of the regular meeting of the Eva Town Council held on September 10, 2013, 6:30 p.m. at the Eva Town Hall. Present: Mayor Livingston, council members Jim Henderson, Johnny Persall, Martin Nelson, Brandlee Shadden, Kent Chambers and Clerk Judy Fortenberry.

Mr. Henderson reported the new edger works great, all sidewalks done.

Reported he had gotten with two different security companies and is waiting on the estimates.

Mr. Henderson reported that he and Mr. Collins had come up with the need of 25 flags @ \$41.50 each that is with poles, for a total of \$1035.00. Will take about a week or two to get them here.
