

Minutes of the Meeting of the Eva Town Council held in regular session on Sept. 11, 1980, at 7 p.m., with Councilmen Mobley, Livingston, Hipps and Morgan attending.

The meeting was chaired by Mr. Mobley. Minutes of the August 14 meeting were read and approved. Financial report giving end of ~~September~~ ^{August} balances was adopted as presented:

Gasoline Tax Fund	53.48
Revenue Sharing	412.76
Volunteer Fire Dept	781.81
Passbook Savings (Gen. Fund)	32.88

The clerk noted that necessary correspondence had been taken care of, per last meeting. Mr. Mobley reported on progress of the gasoline tank tests underway in Town of Eva. He said that he has more work to do, and then he will get the report completed, discuss it with Mr. Proctor at Civil Defense Office, and put a copy in the Town of Eva files.

Mr. Mobley, being a Trustee of Eva School, met with Mr. Jones and discussed the request we had sent about presenting the educational budget to the Council. He said that they are not ready to report yet, but have not been in a big hurry to do so since the item has not been resolved whether we are going to get the tax money. He said that until we have some money available, they will not plan to do the presentation to the council.

The following items of mail were discussed:

- (1) Invitation to the Continental Breakfast on Monday, Sept. 15, at the Mall.
- (2) Physician's Opportunity Fair to be held Friday, October 10, in Birmingham, from 3:30 to 9 p.m. (Mr. Mobley said that he would get together with the Mayor to prepare for this, and that he would try to get the Mayor to go with him.)
- (3) Letter from TVA regarding planned tours of their facilities and projects--one day-tours beginning Oct. 11. (The Clerk will find out more about the tours--whether family members can go also. The card will be returned with further information requested on the two North Alabama Tours.)

The need to appoint another member to the Council at first meeting in October was discussed. Mr. Charles Nichols had expressed his willingness to serve on the Council if the Council wishes to appoint him.

Bills presented for payment were: Walker Brothers 98¢ for a trowel that was missing from the box of returned items; Water bill \$6.76; Net phone bill \$30.61; Clerk's salary for August \$72.36. The motion was offered by Mr. Livingston; seconded by Mr. Hipps, and carried, to pay these bills, and to transfer \$100 from the ~~gasoline tax~~ ^{general fund} to the gasoline tax fund to pay the street light bill when it comes in.

There being no further business, motion offered by Mr. Morgan; seconded by Mr. Hipps that the meeting be adjourned.
