

Minutes of called meeting of Eva Town Council on October 30, 1992, at 7:00 p.m., with Mayor Ryan, Councilmen Alexander, Fowler, Nichols, Collins and Livingston present. Meeting opened with prayer by Mayor Ryan.

Mayor Ryan stated there are several small items that need to be brought up for discussion.

- 1) Clerk stated she is having some difficulty cancelling the insurance on Senior Director. Mayor will call Willa Dockery, Administrator, and try to resolve this issue along with the Salary Increase. Ruth also has an injured arm and will need some assistance to clean the Center for a few weeks. Mayor instructed Ruth to contact the County for assistance.
Cleo stated he has contacted Upper Rack for an estimate on weekly rug service. He received a price of \$24.00 per month. Motion by Mr. Nichols, second by Mr. Collins (carried) to cancel Unitog and begin using a local company - Upper Rack - for rug service.
- 2) Clerk gave a report on efforts to have a new caution light installed ~~that~~ the 4-way stop. Temple stated some additional work will need to be done as the electrical wires are not high enough above the light. Temple also stated that the charge to add a light would be \$675 and to install a complete new double light would be \$875. Motion by Mr. Collins, second by Mr. Fowler (carried) to have a complete new double light installed. Mayor Ryan will contact Joe Wheeler to have them come out and raise electrical wires or whatever needs to be done to have the situation corrected.
- 3) Discussion concerning paving of Cemetery Road was held with Mayor Ryan to obtain a cost estimate from Shelby and report back at the next meeting for a decision to be made.
- 4) Additional work is needed at the corner of Hwy 55 E. and Adams Road. Street Committee to meet and decide what must be done to fix the area.
- 5) Gary reported that he has contacted L & N and the price was incorrect on the wiring for the Library. Price will be less than quoted as they had doubled up with the individual estimates.
- 6) Bert stated he had received a request to have the Old Town Hall Building painted. Estimates will be obtained and a report to be made at the next meeting.
- 7) Gary stated Jimmy Mosteller had contacted him to advise the Town that he is going to sell the property next to the park, if the Town is interested. Gary will find out the price and advise Council at next meeting.
- 8) The street has been completed off Childers Road. Motion by Mr. Nichols, second by Mr. Alexander (carried) to put rocks on as agreed in previous meeting. Right-of-way deed is on record.

- 9) Clerk has received a letter requesting action on the road by Afton & Dene Fowler. Since this is not a public road, but is used by a school bus, Clerk will check into legalities concerning this problem.
- 10) Letter received from Jerry Thompson (a copy of which is on file with the Town Clerk) requesting an additional \$2,700.00 for Instructional Supplies. Motion by Mr. Nichols, second by Mr. Livingston (carried) to allot the extra money as requested.
- 11) Motion by Mr. Alexander, second by Mr. Nichols (carried) to transfer \$14,000.00, in order for Clerk to give the school a check for their budgeted items.

Motion to adjourn.
