

Agenda for Eva Town Council Meeting October 12, 1989

Old business

- 1-Highway signs. Clerk saw Bob Woodruff in Decatur Tuesday. He said he had intended to make the signs in the shop, but with additional duties he has been assigned, he will not be able to do it. The only thing he knows to do is to order the signs already made up for which he probably would have to bill the Town of Eva.
- 2-National Guard turned down our request (See copy of letter). Mayor wrote to him and to the Governor stating he felt we were not treated fairly.
- 3-Mr. Owens did get out and set the corners at the Park, for which he charged \$500, and was paid same day at his request. They were out here two different days to do the work.
- 4-Mr. Morgan needs to let us know when we should bring up the matter of the mail routes again, and suggest who we go to next.
- 5-Frank Taylor said he would be out in a few days to check on the work to be done on Gravel Ridge Road. He will call Donald Ray Morgan or the Mayor before he comes out because he wants one of them to go also.
- 6-Proposed Ordinance on 18-wheelers is not ready for adoption. Mayor has the file on this at the present time.

New Business:

- 1-Need info on rental of old fire hall to John Smith. How much rent is he to pay? When? Will this have any bearing on Linda McDearmond's using town hall part of the building for occasional birthdays?
- 2-Eva Art Guild has requested the Eva Town Council's endorsement to Proclaim the last full week in September of each year as "Frontier Days." They are pleased with the success of the event and want to make it an annual event if the council approves.
- 3-Would the Council vote to let the Art Guild meet at the Senior Center for their monthly meetings at no charge, instead of meeting at the VFD/Town Hall new building? Some VFD members would prefer that they meet at the Center instead of in this building.
- 4-Would it be possible to get the Library parking lot marked off into parking spaces before next Frontier Days. The lot stayed full all day on Sat., Sept. 30; but more could have gotten in, if spaces had been marked off.
- 5-Clerk is urged to attend the Municipal Management Training Institute in Birmingham Nov. 16-17. Registration is \$75; hotel room would be \$59 per night for 2 nights.
- 6-Mayor, Mr. Collins, Mr. Morgan and Clerk met with Nora Landers from NARCOG about a grant request for sewer service at industrial park, etc.
