

Minutes of Special Meeting of Eva Town Council held on 17 October at 4 PM at Eva Town Hall.
Present: Mayor Gary Livingston, Council Members: Kent Chambers, Edsel Childers, Johnny Persall,
Martin Nelson, Ripley Fowler, Town Clerk, Kathy Taylor, and Assistant Town Clerk Kimberly Cryer.

Mayor called meeting to order; After roll call Mayor Livingston informed all present that we open our meetings with prayer, if anyone objects, we will abstain from this practice at today's meeting. No one objected, Mayor Livingston asked Mr. Nelson to lead in prayer.

A. CONFERENCE CALL WITH RSA

Mayor Livingston called Crystal with RSA to discuss RSA benefits for our employees. After talking with Crystal, Mr. Chambers requested Council discuss and vote on it when they discern where the \$30,000 will come from.

B. NEW SEWER RATES

Council discussed that new sewer rates be 50% of water bill since customer will be responsible for repair or replacement of the pump and panel. Mayor Livingston asked for a motion to pass 50% rate. Mr. Nelson so motioned; Mr. Chambers seconded; All ayes-motion carried. Clerk to send rate decision to Danny at Cullman County Water Department. Clerk noted also that any Customer Agreements filed with the Morgan County Probate would be \$15.00 per copy.

C. PAVING

Mayor stated that Larry Madison verified the Town may divide paving projects into three different bids- Basketball/Pickleball courts as one coming from ARPA funds, Courtney Drive as one coming from Special Projects, paving the parking lot for the shelters and above bathroom pavilion as one coming from Streets and Roads. Council did not vote on Helipad at this point. Mayor Livingston asked for a motion to pass doing all three projects. Mr. Childers so motioned; Mr. Chambers seconded; All ayes-motion carried.

D. ICE MACHINE FOR MULTIPURPOSE CENTER

Mayor said the ice machine at the center has stopped working and repair parts are not available. Kathy brought three bids and Council discussed purchasing another one for \$2000.00. Mayor Livingston asked for a motion to purchase an ice machine for the center. Mr. Childers so motioned; Mr. Chambers seconded; All ayes-motion carried. Kathy will order replacement.

E. SEWER ORDINANCE

Mayor asked for discussion about amending current Sewer ordinance. The amendment would change required hook up to sewer from 500 feet to 0 feet for all new structures within the town.

Mayor Livingston requested a motion to adjourn, Mr. Nelson so motioned, Mr. Childers seconded; All Ayes- motion carried. Meeting adjourned.
