

Minutes of the called meeting of the Eva Town Council held on Thursday, November 21, 1996, at 3:00 P.M.. Present: Mayor Livingston, C. C. Mosteller, James Fowler, Clarence Alexander, Larry Smith, and Bert Collins late arrival due to medical appointment. Clerk absent due to family medical emergency. Mayor Livingston took notes for minutes.

Mayor advised that Pepsi Cola has offered to place their cola machine in front of fire department, furnish drinks, and send the fire department a check for the profit. They will completely maintain the box. An electrical plug needs to be placed on outside wall for connection. Mr. Smith made motion to allow cola machine to be placed in front of fire department and fire department pay any expenses for electric outlet, Mr. Mosteller second, carried.

Mayor explained that he and Mr. Fowler met with Jean Deese concerning the streets at the Jean Deese subdivision. Mr. Deese asked that council accept the paving without any asphalt. Mr. Fowler ask if town could do paving and Mr. Deese reimburse the town. After discussion, Mayor advised that motion has already been made in previous meetings that Subdivision paving must be to Morgan County specs. Mayor will call Shelby Contracting to check the paving.

Councilman Alexander introduced Ordinance # 1 (3) as amended, An Ordinance to establish the order of procedure for meetings of the council, to authorize and establish certain committees, to provide for their appointment, and to establish and set out the duties of certain officials of the Town of Eva, Alabama. Councilman Smith moved that all rules governing the council which might, unless suspended, prevent the passage and adoption of the ordinance at this meeting, be and the same are hereby suspended for the purpose of permitting the said ordinance to be finally passed and adopted at this meeting. Councilmember Fowler seconded the motion.

Mayor put question before the council and on roll call the vote as follows:

Councilman Smith moved that the said Ordinance # 1 (3) as amended, and title as introduced, be finally passed and adopted as introduced. Councilman Mosteller seconded the motion.

ORDINANCE # 1 (3) AS AMENDED TO SECTION 5, 6, and 7

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE ORDER OF PROCEDURE FOR MEETINGS OF THE COUNCIL, TO AUTHORIZE AND ESTABLISH CERTAIN COMMITTEES, TO PROVIDE FOR THEIR APPOINTMENT, AND TO ESTABLISH AND SET OUT THE DUTIES OF CERTAIN OFFICIALS OF THE TOWN OF EVA, ALABAMA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EVA, ALABAMA, to amend Section 5, 6, and 7 to read as follows:

SECTION 5. Special meetings may be held at the call of the Mayor by serving notice on each member of the Council not less than twenty-four hours before the time set for such special meetings; or special meetings may be held as provided by Section 11-43-50, Code of Alabama, whenever two councilmembers making the request shall have the right to call such meeting. Notice of all special meetings shall be posted on a bulletin board accessible to the public at least 24 hours prior to such meeting. In municipalities of less than 12,000 in population, the mayor is the presiding officer of the council.

SECTION 6. A quorum shall be determined as provided by Section 11-43-48, Code of Alabama.

SECTION 7. All regular meetings shall convene at 7:30 p.m. May 1 through October 31, and 6:30 p.m. November 1 - April 30, at the Eva Town Hall and all meetings, regular and special, shall be open to the public.
