

Minutes of the meeting of the Eva Town Council held in regular session November 5, 1990, at 7 p.m. attended by Mayor and Councilman Morgan, Nichols and Page. Visitor present Tony Holcomb, representing Eva Activities Association.

Meeting was opened with prayer by Mayor Ryan. Motion by Mr. Morgan, second by Mr. Page (carried) to approve minutes as written. Financial report was handed out on bills to be paid.

Old Business:

1. Recreation Park Status:
  - a) Sprinkler System: Sprinkler System was never installed.
  - b) Walking Trail: After review by LWCF, it looks like we will only be able to obtain appx. \$5000 of \$10000 Grant. County Engineer cannot sign time sheets as logs were not kept on file. Per Jon Strickland's visit, there could possibly be some "roll back money" available. He will check and keep us posted.

Overall, Mayor Ryan suggested that the Activities Assoc. go ahead and get the infield ready with dirt, etc. with their money and we meet back with them shortly to get our priorities organized to get everything working.
2. Census: Letters were sent to Don Hale, Tom Drake, Howell Heflin, Richard Shelby and Ronnie Flippo requesting aid on the Census Count.
3. Road Requirement specs per John Ryan's request:

The Mayor stated that John Ryan will be building a house on on property needing a road. Motion by Mr. Nichols, second by Mr. Page (carried) to rock the road and provide maintenance if they will deed land for road to the Town of Eva.
4. Ordinance on Tractor Trailer Parking to have called meeting to prepare draft.
5. Industrial Park:
  - a) Sign: Mayor suggested that we wait until he has a chance to talk with the County Commission before obtaining a sign due to naming, etc.
  - b) Grading: County has done quite a bit of work and leveling will be done on both sides. Mr. Nichols made a motion to rent a turning pull for appx. 1 week to complete the leveling, if the county does not do so. Second by Mr. Morgan (carried).
6. Annual Appreciation Dinner was successful. Gloria Ashley was selected as Volunteer of the Year with Dennis Holmes selected as Fireman of the Year.
7. \$4500 sent to Brewer School for Lockers and Band Uniforms.
8. Letter of appreciation sent to Brewer Band for their participation in Frontier Days.
9. Volunteer Fire Dept. Blood Drive will be on Nov. 10 from 9 am - 2 pm at the Senior Center.
10. Motion by Mr. Morgan, second by Mr. Page (carried) to obtain earthquake insurance as suggested by Virgil Fowler at a cost of \$265/yr.

11. Per Ken Smith, Attorney, Ala. League of Municipalities, he sees no problem with the Town setting aside funds for a sewer system. Motion by Mr. Nichols, second by Mr. Page (carried) to set aside funds monthly beginning with Oct. 1990, for a sewer system.

New Business:

1. Motion by Mr. Page, second by Mr. Morgan (carried) for Clerk to request municipal tags for Fire Trucks.
2. Motion by Mr. Nichols, second by Mr. Morgan (carried) to grant request from Linda McDearmond to use the Senior Center on Jan. 4, 1991, for Brownie Troop "spend the night" party, even if extra funds are needed for clean-up.
3. Received \$1558.91 from Alabama League of Municipalities on delinquent insurance license taxes. Clerk also requested addresses from League in order to send them notices in the future.
4. Adopt-a-Ship requested to use Old Town Hall. Mayor and Council agreed to let them use facility as long as it is not rented.
5. Mayor/Clerk/Council Members Donald Ray Morgan and Charles Nichols attended a recycling meeting at the Courthouse.
6. Eva IDA needs 3 new members as Stanley Hall, Gwinn Mason and Charley Alexander come off the board this year. Several suggestions were made and the Mayor will report back with acceptance and appointments at next meeting. Christmas Meeting will be Dec. 11 at Bobby's.
7. North Ala. Mayor's Assoc. Christmas Party will be Friday, Dec. 7, at Executive Inn/Madison at 6:30 pm. Clerk needs number attending by Nov. 16.
8. Eva Art Guild will host Christmas parade on December 1 at 11 am and the Tree Lighting Ceremony at 5 pm. They will also host a Hayride at 4 pm on Nov 17.
9. Eva will host Mayor/Clerk meeting on Dec. 17 at Bobby's.
10. Alabama Department of Environmental Management contacted. They will authorize payment upon submission of bills for clean-up from Gas Leak Tests around B & M.
11. Clerk presented information concerning Adopt-a-Mile program to Council. Mayor and Council agreed to participate in this program with Clerk serving on County Committee.
12. Motion by Mr. Page, second by Mr. Nichols (carried) to continue contract with Ray Whisenant/Accountant. Annual audit will take place week of Nov. 12.
13. Rental of Old Town Hall: Motion by Mr. Nichols, second by Mr. Morgan (carried) to rent Old Town Hall to Jerry Livingston for 6 months at \$250/month. Rent after the first 6 months period will be at the rate of \$400/month. Council instructed Clerk to work up contract including provision should we get a buyer for the property.
14. Motion by Mr. Nichols, second by Mr. Page (carried) to authorize payment of bills as presented and to make transfers as presented with an addition to transfer of \$8400 for Sewer Fund.

Motion by Mr. Morgan, second by Mr. Page (carried) to adjourn.
