

Minutes of the regular meeting of the Eva Town Council held on November 14, 2006 at 6:30 p.m. at the Eva Town Hall. Present: Mayor Gary Livingston; Councilmember's: Bert Collins, Johnny Persall, Kent Chambers, Mr. Alexander and Clerk Judy Fortenberry.

Guests: Rev. Joey Coots - Journey Church
Shelia Burt Eva School

Mayor Livingston called the meeting to order. After roll call, informed all present that we open our meetings with prayer, if anyone objected we would abstain from this practice at tonight's meeting. No one objected. Mayor Livingston asked Rev. Coots to open with prayer.

James Henderson arrived at 6:40 p.m.

Rev. Coots left the meeting at 6:45 p.m.

Mr. Collins motion to dispense with reading of the minutes until after hearing from our guest, Mr. Persall seconded, carried.

Mayor Livingston turned the meeting over to Ms. Burt Principal of Eva School. Ms. Burt thanked the Council for the money given to the school then went into detail of the emergency plan that is in place if the need arise for several occurrences. Informed the Council that they have had two drills that went very well, children are supervised at all times, visitors sign in at the office at the front of the building before going into the remaining building, and downstairs doors are locked once the buses have dropped the children off. All out-laying buildings are locked except during class change, upstairs in the main building class rooms are locked at all times, can communicate with all rooms in the buildings. She stated that replacement cameras are needed, since the ones in the old building were misplaced or stolen during the construction of the new building. There are 420 children and 37 teachers at the present time. Ms. Burt came to the meeting at the request of the Mayor and Council.

Mayor Livingston asked if everyone had read the minutes of the Regular Council Meeting of October 10, 2006, Mr. Alexander motion to approve the minutes, Mr. Chambers seconded, motion carried. Call Meeting on October 31, 2006, Mr. Henderson motion to approve Mr. Collins seconded, carried.

A. FINANCE, EDUCATION & LIBRARY- MR. CHAMBERS

Mr. Chamber reported that a check for \$2,500 was presented to Brewer High School and one to Eva School for \$7,500.

Also reported that we had transferred money from CD's and General Fund to the Sewer Fund to make a payment - will bill EPA for this money at the end of the project and return the money to the General Fund.

B: UTILITIES & STREETS- MR. ALEXANDER

C. PARKS, RECREATION & CEMETERIES - MR. PERSALL

Mr. Persall asked if anyone knew of any lights out at the park, and stated that the Clerk will get the equipment at the park serviced and cleaned.

D. POLICE, FIRE & GRANTS – MR HENDERSON

Mr. Henderson asked if we had wrote to the Attorney General to see the amount of authority the Deputy that we pay for has. After discussion Mr. Henderson motion to write and ask for a ruling from the Attorney Generals Office Mr. Persall seconded, carried.

Mr. Henderson reported that he had talked with NARCOG about a Community Plan, and suggested that we have Mr. ? meet with the Council and discuss this.

E. SANITATION & BUILDINGS – MR. COLLINS

Mr. Collins reported that the sewer project is coming right along, and they are doing a good job.

Mayor Livingston reported that he had talked with Johnny Johnson about a paging system to be installed at the sewer plant once it is up and running, also stated that he planned on talking with Johnson Mechanical Services about taking care of the plant and pumps.
