Call meeting of November 21, 2005, 5:00 p.m. at the Eva Town Hall. Present: Mayor Gary Livingston, Council Members Cleo Alexander, Bert Collins, Johnny Persall, Jim Henderson and Town Clerk Judy Fortenberry. Kent Chambers could not attend due to work commitment.

Mayor Livingston opened the meeting after roll call, stated the reason for the meeting was to discuss the waste water treatment project bids. Mayor Livingston pointed out that we have a problem with the low bidder. Stated that Hokes Bluff Construction Company made an error on their bid for Contract No. 1, they had misinterpreted the "Deductive Alternates" instead of the price for this item their bid should have been \$6,890.00 instead of \$54,002. 50. Mayor emphasized this would have to be approved by Rural Development and we would need to clear this through out Attorney to make sure this could be accepted under State Bid Law.

After a lengthy discussion Mr. Collins motioned to accept the bid upon receipt of the Lawyers Opinion and that we could do this under State Bid Law, Mr. Alexander seconded, carried.

Mayor Livingston presented two quotes for the design of the drainage at the recreation park.

CDG Engineers and Associates quote of \$6,900.00

Pugh Engineering services quote of \$7,500.00

St Johns – did not return call nor submit a quote

After discussion Mr. Henderson motion to accept quote from CDG Engineers and Associates for \$6,900 for design of drainage problems at recreation park, Mr. Persall seconded, carried.

Mayor Livingston reminded everyone of the Christmas Parade on December 3rd, at 11:00 a.m.; Clerk confirmed that the Sheriff's Department would have deputies out to block roads as required.

Mr. Alexander motion to adjourn, Mr. Henderson seconded, carried.
