

Minutes of the regular meeting of the Eva Town Council held on November 8, 2005, at 6:30 p.m. in the Eva Town Hall. Present: Mayor Gary Livingston; Councilmember's: Kent Chambers, Bert Collins, Clarence Alexander, James Henderson, Johnny Persall and Clerk Judy Fortenberry.

Guests: Joe Hill, Tommy Shickles

Mayor Livingston called the meeting to order. After roll call, informed all present that we open our meetings with prayer, if anyone objected, we would abstain from this practice at tonight's meeting. No one objected. Mayor Livingston asked Mr. Henderson to open with prayer.

Mayor Livingston asked if everyone had read the minutes of the Regular Council Meeting on October 11, 2005, Mr. Collins motion to approve the minutes, Mr. Alexander seconded, motion carried.

A. FINANCE, EDUCATION & LIBRARY- MR. CHAMBERS

Mr. Chambers reported on the 25th Anniversary Party at the Eva Library – Library Personnel did a great job.

Mr. Chambers reported that Jackie Kinney with Eva School had asked for \$1,500.00 for the reading program. Mr. Chambers motion to give \$1,500. to Eva School for the Reading program, and \$4,000 to the writing program, Mr. Collins seconded, carried.

Clerk reported that Brenda Aday had requested money from the Town to pay for the handicapped children at Sparkman Special Education to attend the circus this coming weekend; Ms Aday reported that several children in this area attend the special education classes at Sparkman. Since we have no money for out side the Eva/Brewer School District, Council Members gave \$67 out of pocket for the children to attend.

B: UTILITIES & STREETS- MR. ALEXANDER

Mr. Alexander reported that the paving in front of the School will proceed next week.

Mr. Alexander reported lights out at firehouse, 4-way stop, and Brenda Whites House.

C. PARKS, RECREATION & CEMETERIES – MR. PERSALL

Mr. Persall reported that the seeding, fertilizer and grub control was put-out on the ball fields and park this past week.

Mr. Persall requested that we start on the drainage design at the park as soon as possible. Mayors requested Clerk to call CDG Engineers, St John's Construction, and Pugh Engineering Services and arrange a meeting for each to look at the problems so they can give us a quote on the cost for the design. Clerk will call and set up dates with each company.

D. POLICE, FIRE & GRANTS – MR HENDERSON

Mr. Henderson reported that he had talked with CWF Construction Company, Hopper's Building Supply and Randy Childers Construction Company, and only Frost had given him a quote for the addition to the Fire House/Town Hall Building. At present time he has one quote from CWF Construction and will hold until next meeting.

Mr. Henderson reported on the meeting he and Mr. Collins attending sponsored by Alabama Rural Water Association in Anniston.

E. SANITATION & BUILDINGS– MR. COLLINS

Mr. Collins reported that the Bid Opening date for the Wastewater Treatment Plant is set of November 15, 2005 at 10:00 A.M. at the Eva Town Hall.

Mr. Collins reported that Representative Aderholt's office had called and said they had put \$200,000 in special appropriation fund in the USDA Rural Development Bill for 2006. We will need to apply for these funds.

Mayor reported that we may need to send Tommy Shickles to work with Falkville, Priceville or Vinemont at least 3 days a week this winter for on job training. This was tabled for the present.

Mr. Chambers's motion to transfer \$10,000 from the General Account to the Sewer Account, Mr. Collins seconded, carried.
