

Minutes of the Meeting of the Eva Town Council held in regular session on Nov. 13, 1980, attended by the Mayor, Councilmen Mobley, Livingston, Nichols, Hipps and Morgan. Mayor Ryan chaired the meeting.

Minutes of the October 9 meeting were read and approved. Financial report giving end-of-October balances was adopted as presented:

Councilmen Mitchell Hipps and Charles Nichols were administered the Oath of Office. The Mayor welcomed Mr. Nichols to the Council.

Old Business:

The 2-¢ tax was discussed. The Mayor read excerpts from the judge's decree on the tax issue. Mr. Mobley offered the motion, seconded by Mr. Hipps, that the Town Council adopt Ordinance 80-1 to require all persons, firms or corporations in the Town of Eva, paying taxes to the State Dept. of Revenue, give a copy of such tax return pertaining to Morgan County tax to the Clerk, Town of Eva, in order for her to compute the information required by the Morgan County Commission so that the Town of Eva receives its portion of the tax. Motion carried. A copy of said Ordinance is attached for the record.

Discussion followed concerning the priority listing from Eva School of proposed school year 1980-81 expenditures. Mr. Livingston offered the motion, seconded by Mr. Morgan that the Town Council pledge (from our share of said school tax) capital outlay funds from the tentative budget, to Eva School for these projects:

Motion carried. Four voted for; Mr. Mobley abstained.

Since Mr. Childers has not built the porch at entrance to Eva Senior Citizens Center, Mr. Mobley offered the motion, seconded by Mr. Nichols that the Town of Eva buy the materials for this. Motion carried.

New Business:

Mr. Mobley offered the motion, seconded by Mr. Hipps to pay the following bills, as well as authorization to pay the electric bills that have not been received: Past 5 months power bills at Senior Citizens Center \$170.23; Yard mowing to Howard Millwood \$87.50; Water bill \$6.76; Gas for Senior Citizens Center \$87.62; Net phone bill \$33.07; Clerk's salary for October \$37.33; Postage \$15.00. Motion carried.

Mr. Mobley offered motion, seconded by Mr. Livingston, to increase the Clerk's salary from \$3.10 to \$4.00 per hour. Motion carried.
