

Minutes of the regular meeting of the Eva Town council held on May 9, 1995, at 7:30 p.m. in the Eva Town Hall. Present: Mayor Livingston, Charles Nichols, James Fowler, Clarence Alexander, and absent was Bert Collins due to death in family and Larry Smith due to conditions beyond his control. After roll call by Mayor, Mr. Alexander opened the meeting with prayer. Guest present was Eloise Livingston, chairman of Library Board and Jamie Wallace member of Medical Clinic Board.

Mrs. Livingston reported that the summer reading program at the Library will begin June 5th two weeks after school is out. The program will be presented by people from the community who are in the education field or that assists in the field. She also reported that the Eva Library's computer had arrived at Wheeler Basin Regional and they were beginning to check it out and have ready for "on-line" service in Eva. Eva Library should have possession in approximately three weeks. A statistics report was not given.

1. FINANCE AND EDUCATION - MR. NICHOLS

Mr. Nichols stated that the sign needed to be repaired at the Library. Mayor advised that he had not been able to reach the vendor who furnished it.

Mayor reported that he talked with Calvin Spurlin, Local Government Revenue Consultant, concerning a meeting with council to work out something for additional revenue from privilege license and sales tax. Mr. Spurlin advised he would be more than glad to work with the town. Work sessions will be set at a later date but will be soon so that any additional expected revenue could be included with the budget for FY 95/96.

Also, Mayor reported that the Medical Board now has \$15,000 C. D. at Eva Bank @ 6.25% for twelve months. The total insurance coverage at the bank has been increased to \$400,000.

2. UTILITIES - MR. ALEXANDER

Mr. Alexander reported that the icemaker (recently purchased) at the Nutrition Site was taken to Jack's Foodland and Larry Smith had it repaired. The icemaker did make ice but it also melted. Larry Smith will have it fixed.

Mr. Alexander also reported that he showed Mr. Sumerford the ditch that was being filled with debris on Frost Rd.

3. PARKS, STREETS & CEMETARIES - MR. FOWLER

Mr. Fowler reported that the large wash on the east side of the park was worse and really needed to be fixed. Ricky Frost is suppose to spread the gravel on the walking trail and fix a washed area. Ricky has not been able to do so due to his father's ill health but will do so as soon as possible. Also, reported that the park was covered with trash Monday after the week-end games and some trash was picked up later in the week but not all. Mayor reported that two teenage boys were to work in the park this summer supervised by Jamell Graham. He will contact her concerning cleaning up the park.

Mayor advised that Tom Drake, Attorney, is processing the deeds on the property for cemetery expansion to send Winford Morgan. Mayor will also discuss with Larry Bennich, Morgan County Commissioner, starting the process for cemetery expansion. Mayor will meet with Joe Sumerford concerning paving the cemetery road, repairing the drain at Quality Drug parking lot, and discuss the large washed area at the Park. In addition, Mayor will go over striping lines and markers for the curve that is so dangerous on 55 E in front of Eva Tire, patching in front of Edsel Childers' house on 55E, and patching in the curve on 55W.

4. POLICE & FIRE - MR. SMITH

No report since Mr. Smith was absent. Mayor advised that he was going to discuss with Sheriff Crabbe possibly having the deputy collect for delinquent licenses.

5. RECREATION & SANITATION - MR. COLLINS

Since Mr. Collins was absent, Mayor advised that Eva Activities had still not made any report to him or Mr. Collins. He also stated there was a sewer problem at Eva School that he had discussed with Ray Cheatham, member of board for Morgan County Schools. Ray advised that Morgan County Board of Education would repair the problem.

9. Other Business

Mayor advised Sherman Powell, Jr., Attorney, to settle the lawsuit with National Health Care concerning the Medical Clinic Office. If they would just pay for the office without any additional monies or that the office does belong to Town of Eva.

Mayor reported that he, Jerry Thompson, Eva School Principal, Jim Nix, First Bank of Eva President and Bert Collins made a trip to Montgomery to meet with Tom Drake and visit a school that had an advanced computer system. However, Tom Drake was not available and the group went ahead to the school only to find that the system is like what Eva School got 10 years ago. Eva Principal is trying to raise funds to put a new system in the Junior High School and move the current system to Elementary. Mr. Thompson will be sending a letter of request to the Town of Eva concerning assistance in the project.

Mayor advised council of Clerical meeting June 23rd and 24th. He advised that Clerk had agreed to pay room expense if the Town could pay for registration and expenses. Mayor also advised that the Town had not paid for any training expense for Clerk since she had received scholarships for the past five training events. Mr. Nichols made motion that Town pay for room, registration and expenses for the meeting, Mr. Alexander, second, carried.

Mr. Alexander made motion to adjourn, Mr. Nichols, second, carried.
