

Minutes of called meeting of Eva Town Council held May 22, 1991, at 4:00 p.m., at Eva Town Hall with Mayor Ryan and Councilmen Nichols, Page, Livingston and Collins present.

Mayor stated the purpose of this meeting is to discuss police protection issues. Clerk reported information received from Willa Dockery, County Commissioner's Office. Per Willa, at the Commission's last meeting, they agreed to allow the Town of Eva to pay through the County for a 40-hour Deputy for the Eva area only. Costs for this Deputy will be appx. \$22,600 (see breakdown on file). She was uncertain about a new car purchase. The County Commission and the Town of Eva would need to execute a contract on a yearly basis with all expenses spelled out each year. This contract would also include a 30-day termination notice clause for each party.

After discussion, the Council agreed that they will still attend the Commission meeting on May 28, at 10:00 a.m., to have this agreement made clear and to request a part-time person (20 hours per week) in addition to this 40-hour Deputy.

Mayor updated the Council on the progress toward a new Sewer Plan. Mayor spoke with Watkins Engineering and they advise that now is the time to begin applying for Grants to assist in the Sewer Project. Mayor stated that Eva may want to consider using an independent company to apply for this Grant as they are usually more aggressive than NARCOG. After discussion, motion by Mr. Nichols, second by Mr. Collins (carried) for the Mayor to pursue an independent company to apply for the Grant money for the Town of Eva's Sewer System.

Motion by Mr. Nichols, second by Mr. Livingston (carried) to pay bill presented by L & N Electric for \$4,072.00 for electrical work done at the Recreation Park. Motion by Mr. Collins, second by Mr. Page (carried) to transfer \$4,000.00 from T-Account to General Fund to take care of this payment.

Motion to adjourn by Mr. Page, second by Mr. Collins (carried).

Minutes of called meeting of Eva Town Council held May 13, 1991, at 4:00 p.m., at Eva Town Hall with Mayor Ryan and Councilmen Nichols, Page, Morgan, Livingston and Collins present.

Meeting was opened with prayer by Mr. Nichols. Mayor stated the purpose of the called meeting is to discuss the School Budget Request made by Mr. Jones at the regular meeting.

In discussions concerning this request for \$30,000 for 1 teacher's salary and a P.E. Aide, it was brought out that at a previous meeting, the Council agreed when they got out from under the Salary Commitment before, they would only consider funding things to improve school facilities. It was also discussed that the Council is unable to determine now what they will be able to commit to the school for the year 91-92 as budget reviews will not be considered until closer to the new fiscal year.

Motion by Mr. Page, second by Mr. Nichols (carried) for Clerk to call Mr. Jones with information that the Council cannot, at this time, advise what funds will be available for the school for next year. The request for funds must come to the Council in the form of a priority list and they will make the decision what items to fund at that time.

Clerk presented Resolution 91-6 for approval (Authorization for Mayor to enter Host Agency Agreement within the SENIOR AIDES Program). Motion by Mr. Collins, second by Mr. Livingston (carried) to approve resolution as presented.

A short discussion was held concerning the proposals Sheriff Crabbe presented at the regular meeting. The police protection committee and the Mayor will have a called meeting on May 22, at 4:00 p.m., to further discuss what will be acceptable. Council requested Clerk to call County Commission to be put on the Agenda for the next regular meeting to discuss this issue with them. (May 28).

Mayor also asked the Street Committee to get with Gafton Ryan to get the ditch problem repaired in front of Buddy Norris' home.

Motion to adjourn by Mr. Page, second by Mr. Morgan (carried).
