

Minutes of Meeting of Eva Town Council held in regular session May 11, 1989, 7 p.m., attended by Mayor Ryan and all 5 members of the Council. Darrell Eddleman represented Eva Activities Association. Meeting was opened with prayer by Mr. Collins. Council voted to dispense with reading of minutes until after we discuss Park Status with Mr. Eddleman. Nothing new on park development, but Mayor said that we are still hopeful we can get the Guard to do the ground work; that we sent a copy of the new sets of drawings to the Guard in Athens and Montgomery and we hope to hear something as soon as the Project Board meets in August. Council voted to get Mr. Walter Owens out as soon as he can to set the corners so that that will be finished before we start moving dirt. Mr. Eddleman gave Clerk the names and addresses of the people at Intergraph who should receive a letter of appreciation from the Mayor.

Minutes of the April 13 meeting were read and approved. A financial report was available for each member of the Council.

#### Old Business:

- 1-The two Alabama Reunion flags were ordered and are supposed to be delivered in time for the May 22 parade day.
- 2-Brewer Band Boosters: We haven't received a priority list of needs from Dr. Wisener at Brewer, so nothing can be done until we hear from him. Clerk called Ala. League Attorney Ken Smith who had worked on this before. He said that while the Town can legally appropriate funds to Brewer School because it is a public institution and Eva students attend the school, the Town cannot legally appropriate funds direct to the Band Boosters because it is made up of private individuals. Although they support Brewer School with the band, music, etc., fund appropriations cannot be appropriated to them directly. Council's decision is to wait until we hear from Dr. Wisener and not go about this in any illegal manner.
- 3-Clerk prepared a copy of the complete Mail Route package with cover letter from the Mayor and sent it to Mr. Motley in Huntsville on April 19. Mr. Page will follow up on this.
- 4-Mayor said that he and Dennis Johnson measured the water lines; he has to get back in touch with the water department to give them the measurements.
- 5-Mayor said that he talked with Odis Runge about the property for sale, and Mr. Runge said that he would get in touch with his son Bobby in Florida. Martin Nelson said that if he didn't do this soon, that he would get in touch with Bobby. Nelson is on the Eva Industrial Development Board.
- 6-The Town had another complaint about the limbs sticking out to block the view at the Post Office exit. Council voted to ask the County to cut these bushes. (M:Page; S:Nichols; carried)

#### New Business:

- 1-Eva Nutrition Site Council, with the approval of Site Manager, voted to buy a television set for the Site, and they wanted to know if the Town Council would pay to have a cabinet built to house the TV set that could be locked up. Council voted to do this, and Mr. Nichols will get the dimensions, so that the Clerk can get a bid from Ezra Drinkard on building the cabinet.
- 2-Discussed termite problem at the Dental Clinic. Mr. Morgan donated some spray and the Mayor said that he would take care of this so that we wouldn't have to contract the work with one of the Pest Control companies.
- 3-IN OTHER ACTIONS, the Council voted to:
  - a. Purchase the used cabinets from David & Shelby Knight at Madison for \$300. for the new fire hall kitchen. (M:Page; S:Livingston; carried)
  - b. Get the culverts fixed or changed out across the street from Ray Morgan's and at the old Fowler place on 55W. (M:Nichols; S:Collins; car.)

- c. Fix the south end of the Library parking lot where it is washing away and concrete the end of the culvert to keep it from washing.
- d. Pay the bills as presented on attached sheet. (M:Nichols; s:Collins; car.)
- e. To proceed with the publishing of the brochure on the Eva businesses, including the doctors and dentist, school, etc., with cost estimates as outlined by Chris Ryan in his presentation (copy attached), and to order 15,000 to be sent to the area mail routes, Somerville, to hand out at the Eva Alumni Reunion, etc. (M:Page; S:Morgan; carried)
- f. Adjourn. (M:Collins; S:Morgan; carried)
