Minutes of April meeting

Old Business

- 1-Two flags were ordered; supposed to be in before May 22. parade day.
- 2-Brewer Band Boosters: No list yet from Dr. Wisener. Clerk called Alabama League Attorney Ken Smith who had worked on this before. He said that while the Town could appropriate funds to Brewer School because it is a public institution, it could not appropriate funds direct to the Band Boosters because it is made up of individuals (private). Although they support the school with the band, music, etc., funds cannot be appropriated directly. Clerk called Priceville to see how they got around this problem. Their attorney said to allocate X number of dollars; tell the Band Boosters when they order the uniforms to have the company bill Town of Priceville direct for the number of uniforms that would come to this amount of dollars. They in turn would pay the company direct and would have no financial dealings direct with the Band Boosters. This is the second time they have bought uniforms for Brewer to replace those that were beyond repair.
