

Minutes of Meeting of Eva Town Council held in call session May 28, 1987, 1:30 p.m., attended by Mayor Ryan and Councilmen Nichols, Morgan, Hipps and Livingston. Meeting was called specifically to open the bids on fire hydrants. Bidders present were Mr. Todd of Speegle Contracting Co. and Mr. Frank Walker and Mr. Simms from Walker's Corner USA.

Mayor opened the bids in the order the bidders were listed on invitation sheet, after stating that invitations were sent to five; we received four bids; which were:

M.C. Doyle	\$23,638.00
John Apel Co.	\$24,100.00
Walker's Corner USA	\$19,920.00
Speegle Contracting Co.	\$34,000.00

Council voted to have Walker's Corner USA, low bidder, send us a contract to be signed. Mr. Walker will get one prepared and mailed to the Mayor.

While Council was in session, they discussed the bids on paving in front of the fire hall. Asphalt would run \$1750; paving \$2259.98. Mayor said that the bid on the concrete paving for \$2259.98 would be to take out 8" of asphalt and dirt; put in 4" compacted rock and 4" reinforced concrete on top. Council voted to take the \$2259.98 bid on concrete paving.

Mayor reported that the \$3,000 Joe had set aside for helping to pave the Center's parking lot cannot be located in the computer; they are trying to find out what happened to it. He asked if the Council would go ahead and pay the total \$8,000 to the County and let them in turn pay Shelby Contracting, since it was let on a County bid. Council voted to do this.

Council voted to have them proceed with repairs for damage incurred from the gasoline leak problem; to use all funds from the Hazard Account and, if there is any excess; pay it from Gasoline Tax Fund.

Council asked Clerk to charge for reimbursement of her trips to Decatur, etc., on city business @ 22¢ mile.

Mayor talked to Joe to put the culvert in front of the Library as soon as he can get to it.

Discussed putting a flag in the city cemetery. Mr. Morgan said that the city could have the pole at the Post Office as soon as the Post Office moves into the new location.
