The Eva Town Council met Thursday, May 14, 7 p.m. in regular session with the Mayor and all 5 councilmen present.

William Fowler, acting spokesman for residents South of current corporate limits, said that he had signatures on an annexation petition but lacks signatures from about four more property owners before it will be complete. The Council can take no action until the petition in final form has been presented.

Ronnie Ryan, as spokesman for the Board of Director of First Bank of Eva, told the Council that the Bank would like to work with the Council to instill more community pride and to possibly set aside a clean-up week. Possibilities for such a project were discussed, and Mr. Ryan pledged involvement of bank officials financially and supportively with certain limitations, of course, on financial involvement.

Council discussed the Multi-Purpose Center, and the work that had been done to try to stop the water leaking under the south door at the Center. It is hoped that the caulking will take care of the problem. The parking lot at the Center will be paved, and the Council voted to buy 200 chairs and 2 more folding tables. The speaker system has been installed. ~~and the Senior Citizens have paid for getting the piano tuned~~

In other actions, the Council voted to:

- 1-Get new stop signs
- 2-Get a load of gravel for east end of parking lot at the Health Clinic and level it for better drainage.
- 3-Put new crossties at the Clinic parking lot and get the leaves and weeds cleaned out around shrubbery.
- 4-Hire someone to spray with chemical spray to kill weeds around the culverts, fire hydrants and stop signs.
- 5-Get some street repairs done in front of the post office.
- 6-Pave the Library parking lot as soon as culverts have been installed along the frontage at the Library.
- 7-Get bids for the hay on the property north of Eva to be developed into a park and recreation area.
- 8-Pay the bills for the month, as presented, which totaled approximately \$6,000.00.
- 9-Meet on May 28, 1:30 for bid opening on fire hydrants to be placed in the area of the 1986 annexation.
