

Minutes of Call Meeting of Eva Town Council held at 7 p.m. on May 23, 1985, attended by Mayor Ryan and all five members of the Council. Ed Land, Director of the Wheeler Basin Library was a participant in the meeting.

The Mayor announced that the meeting was called to decide on where to locate the new Library and what kind of building would be erected there.

Council voted to put the new Library diagonally across Highway 55 from Town Hall, on the lower corner of the Town's property, rather than on the lot at the 4-way stop where there would be more traffic and less parking space.

Decision was made to build a 30x48 clear span building with front door and exit door; with strip glass by the front door; windows (skylights) next to the ceiling. Plans are for a brick building on a good foundation; inside paneling, strip insulation between the bricks and the paneling. Building would have 1 bathroom and electric space heaters and window airconditioner would be used for heating and cooling.

Bids will be obtained from area contractors.

There being no further business for this call session, the motion was offered (Nichols), seconded (Livingston) and passed that the meeting be adjourned.
