

Minutes of the regular meeting of the Eva Town Council held on May 11, 2010, 6:30 p.m. at the Eva Town Hall. Present: Mayor Pro-Temp James Henderson, Councilmember's: Johnny Persall, Bert Collins, Brandlee Shadden, Kent Chambers and Clerk Judy Fortenberry. Mayor Livingston out of town on vacation.

Guests: Joe Hill, John Holmes, Betty and Kenneth Golden and Robert Halbrooks.

Mayor Pro Temp called the meeting to order; all council members present except for Mayor Livingston. After roll call, informed all present that we open our meetings with prayer, if anyone objected we would abstain from this practice at tonight's meeting. No one objected. Mr. Henderson asked Mr. Collins to open with prayer.

Mr. Henderson dispensed with reading of the minutes until hearing from our guest. Mr. Henderson turned the meeting over to Betty Golden with the Eva Public Library. Ms Golden reported everything is going well, and they are ready for the Summer Reading Program.

Mayor Pro Temp Henderson asked if everyone had read the minutes of the April 13, 2010 regular Council Meeting. Council member Collins motion to approve the minutes, Council member Persall seconded, carried.

A: FINANCE, EDUCATION & LIBRARY– MR. CHAMBERS

Mr. Chambers presented the quotes on the striping of the parking lot at the concession stand and the community center. See Agenda for quotes

Mr. Chambers's motion to accept the quote from Frank Losey for \$850.00, Mr. Shadden seconded, carried.

B: UTILITIES & STREETS– MR. SHADDEN

Mr. Shadden reported on the price for the Welcome to Eva Signs (see attached quote). Mr. Shadden also reported that we had order banners for the four-way for the 4th of July and Frontier Days.

The hole in Robbie Lou Childers yard caused by the drainage from the four-way was discussed, this is a county problem and they will need to address this problem.

Mr. Shadden presented a price for the ball field netting; the best he can find on the internet is \$5,570.00 after check with several companies. Mr. Chambers stated that was not a bad price and he recommended getting a quote from Athens Fence Company to install the netting.

Mr. Persall motion to move forward on this project – would like to get a price from Athens Fence Company. Clerk will call Athens Fence Company and set up an appointment for them to come out and look at the area.

C: PARKS, RECREATION & CEMETERIES – MR. PERSALL

Mr. Persall reported that the open house was very positive, and the turn out great.

Mr. Persall also, stated that several jobs need to be taken care of at the Community Center; John will take care of them.

D: POLICE, FIRE & GRANTS – MR HENDERSON

Mr. Henderson reported the painting at the medical building was looking great, and they are almost done with both sides.

He also reported that the final inspection on the sidewalks went well; there were very few problems to be addressed.

F: SANITATION & BUILDINGS –MR. COLLINS

Mr. Collins reported work on the sewer phase II is coming along slowly, but are beginning to make progress.

Mr. Collins reported several people had complained to him about the problem with noise at the four-way, and the trouble with parking. Was decided that we might control the noise with a noise ordinance, but the parking was not the town's problem but the landowner, Clerk will check with attorney and surrounding towns and see if they have a noise ordinance.
