

Minutes of meeting of Eva Town Council held March 12, 1992, at 7:00 p.m., at Eva Town Hall with Mayor Ryan, Councilmen Page, Nichols, Collins and Livingston present. Also present were Leon Mosteller representing Eva PTO, Terry Poole representing Eva Activities and Phillip Robinson representing Woodmen of the World. Meeting opened with prayer by Councilman Collins.

Motion by Mr. Collins, second by Mr. Page (carried) to dispense with the reading of the minutes until hearing from the visitors.

Leon Mosteller stated that Mr. Jones is resigning as Principal of Eva Jr. High School. Mr. Mosteller asked if the Council had any influence in the selection. The PTO is concerned that we get a good replacement. Mayor Ryan stated that the school is operated by the County School Board and the Town, as a body, does not have any input. Mr. Mosteller was encouraged to have everyone contact their board members and Superintendent to show their interest in the selection.

Terry Poole stated the Activities Association would like to put up a batting cage at the new park, if there are no objections. Motion by Mr. Page, second by Mr. Livingston (carried) to allow the Activities Association to install a batting cage.

Phillip Robinson thanked the Council for allowing the Woodmen of the World to use the Senior Center for their meetings. Mr. Robinson asked the Council for permission to have a road block for the "Make a Wish" program. He has already checked with the Sheriff's Department and was told there were no laws against a road block. All participants will be over 18 years of age. Road block to be held on March 21, if approved. Council stated they had no problem with the road block providing our insurance company had no objections. Clerk will contact the insurance company and then advise Mr. Robinson of the results. Mr. Robinson also asked permission to install a "Woodmen Meets Here" sign in front of the Senior Center. Council was in agreement for the sign to be installed.

Old Business:

1. Recreation Park:
 - a) Lights will be arriving Monday, March 16, and a request for 1/2 payment has been received as per the contract.
 - b) Park clean-up day will be March 14, from 9 a.m. to 12 noon.
2. North Alabama EMS Advanced Life Support License is still in process.
3. Financial records still in audit.
4. Pending Joe Wheeler Lawsuit:

Mayor Ryan contacted Attorney Sanderson (Priceville Attorney) and he agreed to file a brief on behalf of the Town. There will be a charge of \$85/hr. plus mileage, etc.

5. Fire Department Purchase Update:

No Truck found at present.

Ambulance was pulled by Hartselle Ambulance. They have updated their vehicles and will not be putting another ambulance in their area for now.

New Business:

1. Request by the Cemetery Committee for the Town to pay for mowing until the Cemetery fund is replenished in May. Motion by Mr. Collins, second by Mr. Page (carried) to pay for the mowing until funds are replenished in May.
2. Mayor Ryan stated that there may possibly be a change in the Deputy in this area for several months.
3. Motion by Mr. Collins, second by Mr. Livingston (carried) to approve February 13, 1992, minutes as written.
4. Motion by Mr. Nichols, second by Mr. Page (carried) to approve February 18, 1992, minutes as written.
5. Motion by Mr. Page, second by Mr. Nichols (carried) to pay bills and transfer funds as presented.

Motion to adjourn by Mr. Nichols, second by Mr. Collins (carried).
