

Minutes of Meeting of Eva Town Council held in regular session on May 13, 1982, at 7 p.m. with the Mayor and all five councilmen present. Minutes of the April 8 meeting were read and approved. Financial report was accepted as presented, giving end-of-April balances as follows:

Old Business:

- (1) Replies from the banks reported as follows:
 First American Bank; has some interest in possibly fall or winter of 1982.
 Central Bank - not interested.
 First Alabama - interested in discussing again in two years,
 Leeth - cannot expand
 First National, Decatur - not interested
 First State - Maybe after first of year. Bill House and Dalton Guthrie came out to look around. Follow up with them could possibly lead to success within a year or so.
- (2) Doctor: A rough draft of the agreement with the hospital was read. Motion to adopt with minor changes made was offered by Mobley, seconded by Nichols; carried.
- (3) Motion was made by Hipps to take bids for a trailer for doctor's clinic/office; Mobley will develop the information for bidding.
- (4) Tabled discussion on car.
- (5) Gasoline Leak: Letter from the attorney to distributors was read. A copy will be given to each of the gas stations in Eva.
- (6) Paving: Estimates were received from Good Hope Contracting and Greer Construction as follows: Good Hope \$\$2934. for City Hall; \$1246 for repair at Eva 4-Way
 Greer \$3420. for City Hall; \$1240 for repair at Eva 4-Way
 Motion offered by Mobley, seconded by Nichols, to accept Good Hope Contracting. Motion carried. Clerk will notify them.

New Business:

- (1) Birlen Childers wants utility bills transferred to City's name. Motion offered by Nichols, seconded by Hipps to do this. Motion carried. Clerk will take care of it.
- (2) Letter from State Auditor to have Hazard Accounts audited, and sent in to Montgomery. Motion offered by Nichols, seconded by Morgan to have this done. Clerk will follow through.
- (3) There needs to be a call meeting held to discuss work on the Eva Cemetery.
- (4) Motion was offered by Nichols, seconded by Livingston, and carried, to buy the school a new weed eater.
- (5) John Smith requested some wrenches and a foam nozzle for the Fire Dept. Motion was offered by Nichols, seconded by Hipps, and carried to buy these.
- (6) Charles Holmes on behalf of Eva Activities Association requested help to develop a recreation area for community. It was decided that 3 people from Eva Activities Association, and the councilmen, will form a committee to search for property.
- (7) George Cleere, Charles Kirby and Wes Creighton from Council on Legalized Sales was at the meeting and presented benefits as follows:
 - 1-Bootleggers cause law enforcement problems
 - 2-Legal control over sales
 - 3-Funds from taxes
 - 4-47% of deaths in Morgan County are alcohol related.
 They stated that Madison and Jefferson Counties have lower percentage. No action was requested.

- (8) Clerk requested to write to Joe Wheeler about street lights that are out, and one that burns all the time.
 - (9) Bills were presented for payment. Motion offered by Nichols, seconded by Morgan; and carried, to pay the following bills:

 - () Clerk's salary for April \$112.65; Town Hall Water bill \$7.44;
 - Reimbursement to Childers for 3 months water at Senior Citizens Center \$20.28;
 - Reimbursement to Childers for 6 months electric bills at Center \$317.67;
 - () Net phone bill \$38.14.
 - From Gasoline Tax Fund:
 - () Street lights \$122.98;
 - From Volunteer Fire Dept.:
 - () Morgan Co. Assoc. of Vol. Fire Departments for flags for fire plugs \$48.06
 - () 6 months premium on 1960 Dodge truck \$50.00; Eva Texaco gas for fire truck \$21.00; Eva 4-Way gas for fire truck \$14.50.
- Motion offered by Nichols; seconded by Morgan, that meeting be adjourned.
